Under sail, the C&C 35 mkII provides energetic yet predictable performance across all wind conditions. Its powerful masthead sloop rig, robust keel ballast, and responsive spade rudder allow her to track beautifully upwind while maintaining absolute control off the wind. It remains a top choice for sailors who enjoy competitive club racing or spirited weekend coastal cruising.
