The **Beneteau First 310**, designed by the renowned Group Finot, is a standout model in the builder's celebrated "First" lineage. Known for striking a perfect balance between a fast cruiser and an agile club racer, the 310 features a modern, easily driven hull form paired with a powerful rig. Below the waterline, the cast iron fin keel and responsive spade rudder offer excellent stability, impressive tracking, and a light helm that delights single-handed sailors and full crews alike.

On deck, the First 310 boasts an intelligent, ergonomic cockpit layout designed for efficient sail handling. All control lines are led aft to the cockpit through Spinlock rope clutches, ensuring safety and ease of use when trimming the sails. The T-shaped cockpit balances working space for the helmsman with comfortable seating for guests, complete with a fold-up cockpit table, customized cushions, and premium canvas protection, making it as pleasant at anchor as it is under sail.

Steeping below, the interior layout maximizes the yacht's 10' 7" beam to offer an incredibly bright, airy, and functional living space. Unlike many 31-foot sailboats of this era, the First 310 features a true two-cabin layout, providing a private forward vee berth and a generous, enclosed double aft cabin complete with a memory foam mattress. Large opening ports, rich woodwork, and clever storage solutions throughout the main salon create an inviting atmosphere for extended weekend cruising.

What truly sets this specific 1992 Beneteau First 310 apart is its extensive list of high-value upgrades and fastidious maintenance. From its reliable, low-hour repowered Yanmar diesel engine to the state-of-the-art Power Queen Lithium-Ion house battery bank, this boat has been systematically modernized.
