It is designed to track beautifully, point high into the wind, and provide a stable, confidence-inspiring ride under sail, making it a favorite for single-handed sailing or full-crew racing on the Great Lakes.

On deck, the C&C 33 mkII boasts a clean, ergonomic layout optimized for efficient sail handling. This particular model comes equipped with premium rod rigging throughout, newer running rigging, and a cockpit-mounted traveller that places mainsail control right at your fingertips. The deep, secure cockpit features a dodger and bimini enclosure (with new windows updated in 2024), offering excellent protection from the elements during extended passages across Lake Ontario or weekend trips to the Toronto Islands.

Step down the companionway, and you are welcomed by an exceptionally bright and airy salon that feels much larger than its 32' 5" length suggests. The clever 10' 5" beam is maximized to offer full standing headroom, rich wood cabinetry, and upgraded LED interior lighting. Comfort is prioritized throughout the cabin with updated cushion fabrics, a large salon table with drop-leaves for entertaining, a dedicated navigation desk, and a Dickinson propane cabin heater that extends your Canadian sailing season well into the crisp autumn months.

Auxiliary power is delivered by a highly reliable, fresh-water cooled Yanmar 2GM20F marine diesel engine that has been consistently maintained. The vessel's mechanical and electrical systems have seen significant, high-value preventative updates over the last two seasons, including a new engine impeller, a new dripless shaft seal, and a fresh deep-cycle house battery. For a discerning sailor looking for a turnkey, freshwater racer-cruiser in Ontario, this C&C 33 mkII is fully found and ready for its next captain.
