Vessels built by Ouyang Boatworks were designed specifically to handle the demanding, chop-heavy conditions of the Great Lakes while offering the strength required for coastal cruising.

The Aloha series became the hallmark of Ouyang Boatworks, celebrated by Canadian sailors for its robust build quality, timeless aesthetic, and practical sea-keeping abilities. Today, Aloha sailboats remain highly sought after on the pre-owned market for their enduring hull integrity, comfortable interiors, and reliable performance, standing as a proud testament to Canadian boatbuilding excellence.

The Versatile Aloha 32

Designed by the respected naval architect Mark Ellis, the Aloha 32 is widely regarded as one of the finest performance-oriented cruisers in its size class. The design strikes a perfect balance between speed, stability, and interior volume, featuring a moderate displacement hull, a draft of 4' 9" that is ideal for Great Lakes gunkholing, and a generous 10' 9" beam. The Aloha 32 offers an easy-to-handle sail plan that makes short-handed sailing a breeze, whether day sailing off Kingston or embarking on extended summer cruises down the St. Lawrence River.

"Annie's Song" is a very well maintained 1986 model currently located in Kingston, Ontario, long considered the freshwater sailing capital of Canada. This vessel combines classic Canadian craftsmanship with essential modern upgrades like solar power, an electric windlass, and upgraded navigation gear, making it a turnkey solution for sailors looking to explore Lake Ontario and beyond.

On deck, the Aloha 32 features a well sheltered cockpit protected by a dodger, bimini, and connector, complete with comfortable cockpit cushions, a folding wooden table, a Magma BBQ, and dinghy davits at the stern. The spacious layout allows for effortless helm control at the Edson pedestal, with all lines and gear arranged for safe, confident maneuvers.

Below deck, the bright and ventilated interior showcases traditional woodwork, efficient LED lighting, and exceptional storage space throughout. The main salon boasts a full-width drop-down dining table and a port settee that conveniently pulls out to form a double berth. The galley is well appointed with a Force 10 two-burner stove and oven, integrated refrigeration with freezer, microwave, and single sink, while the forward V-berth, aft quarterberth, and private forward head ensure comfortable overnight accommodations for family and guests.
