Built with heavy hand-laid fiberglass, thick glass layups, and robust encapsulated ballast, Bayfield vessels were engineered from the keel up to prioritize structural integrity, safety, and longevity over mass-production speed.

The builder's signature aesthetic, characterized by classic clipper bows, decorative trailboards, and traditional lines, set Bayfield apart from the sea of standard production cruisers of the 1980s. Boaters across Lake Ontario and beyond continue to seek out Bayfield yachts for their timeless beauty, heavy displacement stability, and forgiving sea manners. Owning a Bayfield means owning a piece of classic Canadian marine craftsmanship that continues to hold its value and admiration anywhere it docks.

The Bayfield 29 Experience

The Bayfield 29 represents one of the most intelligent and harmonious balances of classic design, interior volume, and coastal accessibility in the 30-foot cruiser market. Designed by Henry Morschadt, this model offers the aesthetic allure of a traditional cutter-style vessel while utilizing a practical, manageable rig. For couples or small families looking to enter cruising without the steep slip fees and demanding upkeep of larger vessels, the Bayfield 29 strikes an ideal sweet spot, delivering real-boat capability in a compact, highly controllable package.

One of the standout design advantages of the Bayfield 29 is its shallow draft of just 3 feet 6 inches. Anchored by a long full keel, this shallow draft opens up cruising grounds that deep-draft vessels simply cannot reach. Whether navigating the scenic shallow bays of Prince Edward County, exploring the Thousand Islands, or anchoring close to beach shorelines along Lake Ontario, *COASTER* offers unmatched access to prime anchoring spots without sacrificing tracking stability or offshore comfort.

On deck, the layout is designed for secure, stress-free double-handed or solo sailing. Deep cockpit coamings provide reassuring protection from spray and wind, while wide side decks ensure safe movement fore and aft. The sail plan is versatile and easily managed, featuring a fully battened mainsail with lazy jacks alongside furling and cutter options. Equipped with a canvas refresh including a new dodger, bimini, and connector from 2023, the cockpit functions as a comfortable, weather-protected outdoor room for long summer afternoons on the water.

Step below deck and the Bayfield 29 immediately impresses with an interior volume that feels significantly larger than its 29-foot length overall suggests. Thanks to an intelligent 10-foot 2-inch beam and generous headroom, the cabin is warm, open, and traditional. Rich teak woodwork, an efficient galley, a private head, and sleeping accommodations for up to three adults make extended weekend trips or summer vacations along the Great Lakes completely comfortable. *COASTER* is an enticing choice for the sensible boater who values quality, stability, and authentic classic character over unnecessary complexity.
