Hull, Deck and Exterior Wood have been refinished to like new condition.

A Sugar Scoop Transom has been added to the vessel.

- Install two new SS water and one waste deck fitting
- New set of lifelines installed
- New heavy cast bow fitting with twin roller
- Two deck hatches received new glass and gasket

- Custom swim platform addition with Custom stainless swim ladder
