




While it might be tempting to have everyone wear the same plaid pattern or that classic white tee and jeans, photographs truly shine when there's thoughtful coordination without being overly matching. I usually recommend dressing no more than two individuals in the same print/patten.

Consider mixing textures and layering pieces to add depth and interest to the ensemble. Incorporate a variety of shades within a color palette to create a cohesive look without being too uniform.



The goal is to ensure that each person's personality shines through while maintaining a harmonious overall appearance. By thoughtfully selecting outfits, you'll create a visual story that feels both natural and aesthetically pleasing.







Avoid too many pattens, logos or character t-shirts.

Instead, opt for classic, versatile pieces that can be easily mixed and matched.
Solid colors and simple designs are fab!

Additionally, consider layering with a jacket or a cozy cardigan to add dimension to your outfit. Remember, the key is to feel comfortable and confident in whatever you choose to wear.
