34th ANNUAL ITALIAN FESTA IS Back From a 2 Year Covid Suspension


Weis Park - 2600 Harvard & 26th St. NW (Near Malone University)

2022 FESTIVAL PROUDLY DEDICATED TO: Dominic J. Bagnoli Jr. MD

Our Festival Board is delighted to name the Honorable **Dominic J. Bagnoli Jr. MD** as the recipient of our **2022 Festival Dedication Award.**

Dr. Dominic Bagnoli Jr. has a unique connection to the Stark County Italian American Festival. A life long Stark County resident, his father, Dominic Bagnoli Sr., was one of the founders of our Festival and an ardent advocate for the Italian-American community. Dr. Bagnoli has honored his father's legacy with an equally fervent commitment.

Born and raised in Hartville, Dr Bagnoli attended The Ohio State University for undergraduate studies and attended medical school at Wright State University. He completed an emergency medicine residency at Akron General and then founded EMP, an emergency medicine physician group. Since that time his practice has grown to become the nation's largest physician-owned provider of emergency and inpatient medicine in the country. The group, US Acute Care Solutions employs more then 5000 physicians and advance practice providers nation-wide, including at the Summa Health Systems.

Dr. Bagnoli credits his success to his family's humble roots and commitment to education. It's the basis of his family's support for our scholarship and many others including Lake HS, NEOMED, Wright State and The Ohio State University. He is married to his wife of 31 years, Vivian Von Gruenigen, MD and has two children. Their son Dominic Bagnoli III lives locally and is an independent insurance consultant with Maconachy Stradley, and their daughter Elise Bagnoli is attending the School of the Art Institute of Chicago (SAIC) obtaining her Masters of Fine Arts degree in Painting and Drawing. Both children were recipients of our festival scholarship when they graduated from Lake HS. The family loves their Italian heritage and have visited Fossalto, Italy where his grandparents were born and Giulianova Italy where his mother, Maria Pomante was born, many times.

Dr. Bagnoli currently serves as Executive Chairman of US Acute Care Solutions still based here in Canton, and has served on several other national boards including The GI Alliance, Dispatch Health, Stat Health and others. Locally he has supported many non-profits and scholarships funds including the Tschantz-Dueble-Bagnoli Caddy Scholarship and served on the Board of the Congress Lake Company. He also served as President of the American College of Emergency Physicians in Ohio.


