2 Corinthians 5:1 NLT

"For we know that when this **earthly** tent we live in is taken down (that is, when we die and leave this earthly body), we will have a house in heaven, an eternal **body** made for us by God Himself and not by human hands."

Mark 9:47-48 ESV

[Jesus] "And if your eye causes you to sin, **tear [pluck]** it out. It is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye than with two eyes to be thrown into hell, 'where their **worm** does not die and the **fire** is not quenched.'"

"Later, Jesus sat on the Mount of **Olives**. His disciples came to Him privately and said, 'Tell us, when will all this happen? What sign will signal Your return and the end of the world?' [Jesus] 'You also must be ready all the time, for the Son of Man will come when **least expected**.... But what if the servant is evil and thinks, 'My master won't be back for a while,' and he begins **beating** the other servants, partying, and getting drunk? The master will return unannounced and unexpected, and he will cut the servant to pieces and assign him a place with the hypocrites. In that place there will be **weeping** and gnashing of teeth.... Again, the Kingdom of Heaven can be illustrated by the story of a man going on a long trip. He called together his servants and entrusted his **money** to them while he was gone.... But from those who do nothing, even what little they have will be taken away. Now throw this **useless** servant into outer **darkness**, where there will be weeping and **gnashing** of teeth.... Then the King will turn to those on the left and say, 'Away with you, you cursed ones, into the **eternal** fire prepared for the **devil** and his demons.' And he will answer, 'I tell you the truth, when you refused to help the **least** of these my brothers and sisters, you were refusing to help me.' And they will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous will go into eternal **life**."

Luke 16:19-20, 22-24 CSB

[Jesus] "There was a **rich** man who would dress in purple and fine linen, feasting lavishly every day. But a poor man named Lazarus, covered with **sores**, was lying at his gate.... One day the poor man died and was carried away by the **angels** to Abraham's side [to the fold of Abraham's robe]. The rich man also died and was buried. And being in torment in **Hades**, he looked up and saw Abraham a long way off, with Lazarus at his side. 'Father Abraham!' he called out, 'Have mercy on me and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in **water** and cool my tongue, because I am in agony in this **flame**!'"
