Dynasty Meet Schedule 2025-2026

Here is the meet schedule for the 2025-2026 season. All season memberships will need to be purchased by **October 1**st.

Team gymnasts levels 1-2 compete in the **A**mateur **A**thletic **U**nion. AAU meets that we attend are held across the Missouri Valley District (all Kansas Clubs and the far west side of Missouri), Oklahoma district and Missouri Ozarks district. Level 1-2 gymnasts are required to compete in our home meet, and the District Championships, all other AAU meets are optional.

Team gymnasts levels 3-10 and Xcel compete in both AAU and **USA G**ymnastics. USAG meets are held all throughout the US, but this season we will only attend meets held in region 3. Levels 3-10 and Xcel gymnasts are required to attend all regular season meets on our schedule.

Schedule Notes:

- All entry fees include a \$25 coaches travel fee. All required meets will be drafted on the above draft dates. If you would like your gymnast to attend an optional meet, you will need to register them online through the customer portal. If you need assistance, please contact Dakota Bridle.
- Dynasty's home meet and the AAU District Championship is required for all team gymnasts regardless of level. Parent and athlete participation is required for our home meet.
- Only Level 3+ are eligible to compete at USAG State. They must receive a qualifying all-around score at NYI, Land of OZ or Nadia to qualify for State. Levels 3-5 qualifying AA score 30.00, levels 6-10 qualifying AA score 32.00.
- The team will compete in either the Midwest Regional or Nationals in May/June. The coaches will decide which meet to attend after locations for each meet are announced, however our hope is to attend Nationals. Registration is optional for all gymnasts.

AAU Season Memberships \$23

AAU athlete memberships are required for all team gymnasts. Coach Dakota will fill out the membership information for all gymnasts and draft the membership fee of \$23 on October 1st. Please verify that your athlete's date of birth and address is correct in the customer portal.

USAG Season Memberships \$25-\$73

USAG athlete memberships are required for team gymnasts level 3+. Parents will need to purchase their athletes' memberships themselves before October 1st. Follow the steps below to purchase an athlete membership. First time ever USAG memberships are \$25, renewal memberships are \$73.
