## 18. INTRODUCTION.

#### Matt. 5:1-2

I Seeing the crowds, he went up on the mountain, and when he sat down his disciples came to him. <sup>2</sup> And he opened his mouth and taught them, saying:

6:12 In these days he went out into the hills to pray; and all night he continued in prayer to God. <sup>20</sup> And he lifted up his eyes on his disciples, and said:

## Matt. 5:3-12

- <sup>3</sup> "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- <sup>4</sup> "Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.
- for they shall be comfo 5 "Blessed are the meek,
- for they shall inherit the earth.

  6 "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness,

for they shall be satisfied.

- 7 "Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy.
- <sup>8</sup> "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.
- <sup>9</sup> "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.
- 10 "Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account.

12 Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so men persecuted the prophets who were before you.

<sup>20</sup> "Blessed are you poor, for yours is the kingdom of God.

21 "Blessed are you that hunger now,

for you shall be satisfied.
"Blessed are you that weep now,
for you shall laugh.

22 "Blessed are you when men hate you, and when they exclude you and revile you and cast out your name as evil, on account of the Son of man!

23 Rejoice in that day, and leap for joy, for behold, your reward is great in heaven; for so their fathers did to the prophets."

Matt. 5:5—Psalm 37:11. 5:8—Psalm 24:4.

To Matt. 5:5 cf. Clement of Alexandria, *Protrepticus X.94.4*: So the scripture naturally preaches to those who have believed, "And the saints of the Lord shall inherit the glory of God and his power."

To Matt. 5:3 and Luke 6:20 cf. Gospel of Thomas, Logion 54: Jesus said, "Blessed are the poor, for yours is the kingdom of heaven."
