Pontypool Triathlon & Endurance Club Members Code of Conduct

The essence of good ethical conduct and practice is summarised below. All members must:

- By registering for club membership, abide by all club policies and procedures.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with Pontypool Triathlon & Endurance Club, other club and event officials.
- Encourage all fellow club members to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Set a good example to all fellow members by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Publicly accept club coaches and officials' judgements.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Disrespectful language, personal attacks, or aggressive behaviour in any form—whether verbal, written, or non-verbal—will not be tolerated.
- Bullying, harassment, or any form of discriminatory behaviour is strictly prohibited. This includes but is not limited to inappropriate comments or behaviour related to race, gender, sexual orientation, religion, age, or physical ability.
- Any violations of this policy will be taken seriously and addressed according to the club's disciplinary procedures.
- Support all the coaches and officers of the club as volunteers who run the club as a voluntary organisation.
- Be a loyal and committed ambassador for Pontypool Triathlon & Endurance Club
- Publicly promote the club in a positive and supportive manner
- All members are accountable for their behavior and adherence to this
 policy. Any concerns or breaches should be reported to the chairperson or
 designated member.
