

## Short Curriculum Vitae of Andriana Nikoloulia

Andriana Nikoloulia was born in 1995 in Athens, Greece. She has worked as a **Co-Researcher** in a research project of *Hellenic Psychotherapy Laboratory of Brussels*, engaging psychological, social and political aspects of the LGBTQIA+ individuals in Person-Centered Psychotherapy. In addition, as a **Psychologist**, Andriana has worked with children in the area of psycho-motor play at *Ergomilo Plus - Learning Difficulties Center*. She has completed her internships at *18 Ano - Rehabilitation Unit, Department of Problematic Internet Use of Psychiatric Hospital of Attica* as an **undergraduate Psychology student** and at *G-All, Gender Alliance Initiative* as a **postgraduate student**. After her more recent internship she now continues her collaboration with *G-All, Gender Alliance Initiative* as an **External Scientific Associate, Project Manager Assistant** and **Workshop Facilitator**.
