We are self-supporting as the seventh tradition states. The basket is now being passed quietly as we open the floor to anyone who has a need to get current. This allows group support for anyone who feels their sobriety threatened, has broken their bottom line behavior, or just wants to check in with the group. "I've asked to read "The Signs of Recovery" (Conf. Approved) I want to thank everyone for sharing today. The opinions expressed here today are our own and not necessarily those of S.L.A.A. as a whole. Let there be no gossip or criticism of one another, but rather understanding and friendship. Anonymity is the spiritual foundation of all our traditions, ever reminding us to place principles before personalities. The things you heard here were spoken in confidence and should be treated as confidential. So who you see here, what was said here, when you leave here, stays here. A message about 13th Stepping – 13th stepping is manipulating another person in recovery, especially a newcomer, into a sexual, emotional, or romantic relationship. This behavior is wholeheartedly discouraged in S.L.A.A.

Help me to relax and take it easy. Free me from doubt and indecision. Guide me through this day and show me my next step. God, show me what I need to do to take care of any problems. I ask all these things that I may be of maximum service to you and my fellow man. In the spirit of the Steps I pray.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Step Prayer**: God, I offer myself to Thee - To build with me and to do with me as Thou wilt. Relieve me of the bondage of self, that I may better do Thy will. Take away my difficulties, that victory over them may bear witness to those I would help of Thy Power, Thy Love, and Thy Way of life.

**7<sup>th</sup> Step Prayer**: My Creator, I am now willing that You should have all of me, good and bad. I pray that You now remove from me every single defect of character which stands in the way of my usefulness to You and my fellows. Grant me strength, as I go out from here, to do Your bidding.

**Lord's Prayer**: Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, The power, and the glory, For ever and ever.
