International Student Admissions Process and Application

Please follow the outlined steps carefully to avoid any delays in the admissions process. Incomplete applications will not be precessed and may require the application be resubmitted.

1. SUBMIT COMPLETE APPLICATION

Documents Required:

- CCSA International Student Admissions Application
- Complete set of school records (originals & translated)
- Two Teacher recommendations
- Verification of funds available for tuition and fees (Stamped certificate from bank)
- Copy of student's valid passport, visa (if applicable), I-94 (if applicable), and current I-20 (if applicable)
- Documentation of one of the following English profiency test scores:

ITEP SLATE exam

TOEFL (students 15 –18)

TOEFL Junior (students 11 –15)

2. INTERVIEW

Upon receipt of the completed application and official testing results, all information will be reviewed and the student will be considered for enrollment. If all criteria are met, the family and/or student will be invited to participate in a SKYPE interview.

3. ADMISSIONS NOTIFICATION

- Students who are offered enrollment should submit the agreed upon deposit to CCSA via wire transfer.
- Students who are offered enrollment will receive a welcome packet which includes a letter of acceptance and their I-20
 along with other dociments that will need to be signed and returned to complete enrollment. The family is responsible for
 securing the Visa appointment with the Consulate for interview and issuance of the required F-1 Visa.

4. COMPLETE ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Required Documents Original documents must accompany payment for tuition and fees which are due by August 1st for fall enrollment and December 15th for spring enrollment.
