

Lake Petersburg Association Notice of Election

The election of Directors to the Board of Lake Petersburg Association will be held in compliance with the legal requirement of the State of Illinois Legislation entitled Common Interest Community Association Act and Lake Petersburg Association By-Laws.

Due to the resignation of a Board member, this vacancy will be filled according to Election Procedures regarding vacancies in the Lake Petersburg Rules and Regulations; Rule 1.2.2.E. “..., *the same election procedure as a regular election may be followed to fill vacant Director terms.* ...”

Serving on this board is more than just attending a monthly meeting. In making your decision to run for a Director position, keep in mind the amount of time you are able to devote to the position, availability to our members and the ability to work with others. Most board members find they need to spend a minimum of 10 hours a week to adequately cover their committee assignments and issues that arise as the Board serves as the Property Manager. Please see eligibility requirements on the back of this document.

Application forms for 1 available seat will be emailed to the Membership no later than August 31, 2021 and also available on the website and in the office during regular office hours.

Applications will be accepted at the Lake office on Wednesday, September 1st beginning at 2pm through 6pm on Wednesday, September 15th. Ideally, candidates will submit their completed application and bio profile. You may attach a picture, if desired, in electronic form to lakeoffice@lakepetersburg.org. If candidates are unable to submit electronically, applications will also be accepted in the office.

The candidates' positions on the ballot will be determined by the order in which the completed applications including bio are received in the office. All candidates who submit a completed application and bio at or prior to 2pm on Wednesday, September 1st and will be considered submitted at 2pm on Wednesday, September 1st. All candidates who have submitted completed applications and bios at 2 pm on Wednesday, September 1st will have their names placed in a hat and randomly selected for order on the ballot by the office secretary and one other Board member who is not participating in the election.

Candidates' bio profiles will be emailed to the membership no later than Wednesday October 6th. The bio profiles will also be available in the office.

Ballots will be available for voting at 2pm in the office on Wednesday, October 13, 2021. Voting will continue during office hours until 6pm on Monday, November 8, 2021.

The ballots will be reviewed and counted by November 15, 2021. The Membership will be notified of the results via email. The new Director's term will commence with the January, 8 2022 Board meeting.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. A candidate must be a Regular Member of Lake Petersburg Association and in good standing.
2. A candidate must have reached a minimum age of 21 by Election Day.
3. A candidate must have had a membership in the Lake Petersburg Association for a minimum of 1 (one) year prior to Election Day.
4. A candidate cannot be employed by or doing business with the Lake Petersburg Association.
5. Only one person from any membership can be on the board of directors at any one time.
6. A candidate must be current on all dues, fees, fines, penalties, and claims for payment owed to the Lake Petersburg Association.
7. A candidate may not be a convicted felon.
