Dear Bethlehem,

Didn't you love Pastor Art's reflection of the word *pivot* at the

Bethlehem's September Anniversary Celebration? He marveled at the disciple Peter's sudden change of direction, from one who denied knowing the Lord when questioned by a young servant girl, to one who would stand up in a large crowd and call others to a new direction. That was some pivot.

Certainly, the last couple of years have kept us on our toes as an organization ready to make whatever adjustments necessary, from at home worship via Zoom, to communion in the parking lot, to in person with masks, to outdoor mask optional services. There have been a lot of pivots, not only in reaction into outside circumstances, but intentional changes to benefit the congregation like deciding to continue online worship for the benefit of those who are not able to attend in person. You have done remarkedly well with all those pivots people of God, but sometimes, it gets exhausting, doesn't it?

But there is another meaning of the word pivot according to Webster, a noun, rather than a verb.

Pivot, noun

1. the central point, on which a mechanism turns or oscillates.

Jesus is the pivot of Bethlehem Lutheran. He is the central point on which we rotate. Change, new direction can be disorienting and downright scary, so many decisions. The clear message that I've heard in prayer of late is "Don't be afraid." "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways, acknowledge him, and he will direct your path. Proverbs 3: 4,5

Do not be afraid, Bethlehem, as long as Jesus is our pivot. When we are not able to pivot on our own, don't know which way to turn, not able to change ourselves or others; may Jesus, our center, be the one who changes us. May he fill us with hope and courage and move us in new directions for the sake of the gospel. Maybe Peter didn't pull themselves up by his bootstraps and get out there to witness, maybe he just hung in there long enough and close enough to experience the miracle of Pentecost where he was filled with power and spirit of God.

Hang in there Bethlehem; the Lord will direct your path.
