

# WUA Three Doubles Square

It is designed for "Warm Up America" (<http://www.warmupamerica.org>)

---

**Materials:** Red Heart Super Saver worsted weight 100% acrylic yarn, approximately 33-35 grams (1.1 – 1.2 ounces) & a size H (5.0 mm) crochet hook

**Gauge:** 16 dc=4"

**Measurements:** 7" by 9"

**Abbreviations (pattern uses US terms):**

ch: chain

sk: skip

rep: repeat

dc: double crochet

**Pattern:**

Ch 26.

Row 1: Dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook (skipped chains count as dc) & in next 2 ch, sk next ch, \* 3 dc in next ch, sk next 2 ch, rep from \* across 4 times more, 3 dc in next ch, sk next ch, dc in ea of the last 3 ch: 24 dc made.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc, now & throughout), turn. Dc in next 2 dc, sk next dc, \* 3 dc in next dc, sk next 2 dc, rep from \* across 4 times more, 3 dc in next dc, sk next dc, dc in ea of the last 3 dc.

Repeat row 2 until block measures 9". End off. Weave in ends.
