The arrangements in place to limit contact between Clients & Volunteers

- Social distancing adhered to at all times (Government guidelines)
- Clients/care-givers to fill in Registration Forms electronically before a session
- If this is not possible, information to be dictated to volunteer at session
- Clients to provide own refreshments
- Poster will be displayed to remind Clients/Volunteers about social distancing
- Caregivers will be guided(socially distanced) by a volunteer to safely seat and fit safety harnesses and equipment

The arrangements in place to limit contact between Volunteers

- Social distancing to be adhered to at all times (Government guidelines)
- Volunteers to provide own refreshments
- Pens & clipboards to be sanitized after each use

The arrangements in place to allow hand sanitization

- Clients/Volunteers will be reminded of Toilets/Changing Places facility at Brooklands Park, Worthing
- Anti-bacterial hand gel will be provided (60% +)
- Poster will be displayed as a reminder to wash/sanitize hands regularly

The arrangements in place for regularly cleaning equipment and bikes

- All equipment used at a session (bikes, helmets, safety harnesses) will be regularly cleaned with disinfectant
- After each use thorough cleaning with a disinfectant will take place

The arrangements in place for a Volunteer/Client who is showing symptoms

- Volunteers/Clients who are displaying symptoms of COVID 19 will not be allowed to attend a CYCALL session
- If anyone who has attended a CYCALL session (volunteer/client) becomes ill with COVID 19 CYCALL will cooperate with the Track & Trace scheme as necessary

This policy will be reviewed and updated in line with the advice given by the Government
