



Message from Pastor Chris

Lord, is this the time when you will restore the kingdom? ...It is not for you to know ...But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses.

~ Acts 1

When the disciples gathered together with the Resurrected Lord, they had many questions. They wondered what was next. They witnessed, in the Cross and the Resurrection, a God who was doing a new thing. But they couldn't quite put their finger on what that new thing was. Naturally, their anxiety led them to ask Jesus pointedly, is this the time...?

Often, when I listen to folks discuss the future of the church I sense the same kinds of questions and anxiety. What is happening to the church I used to know?' 'Why don't we do this thing or that thing anymore?' 'Is this the time when God might restore it all?'

Thankfully, for our sake, God is not in the restoration business. The restoration of old things and old ways have never been good enough for a Lord who chooses to die and rise again. Restoration was never the gig of a Creator. He thinks much bigger than that!

God's desire, remember, is to make all things new. This, of course, includes His church in the midst of our changing times. The question for us now is: How do we remain faithful in the midst of our anxiety about a changing world and a changing church? This Lent, I invite us to reflect, discuss, and pray about this question. In short, I invite us to explore what it means to be the church in challenging and changing times.

Each Wednesday this Lent, beginning March 4, we will gather for food, fellowship, discussion, and worship around our theme: **Faithful, yet Changing.** What does it mean to be the church that worships, equips disciples, invites others, and prays in the midst of some of the most rapid and radical change this world has ever experienced?

The template for our conversation together comes from the former presiding Bishop of the ELCA, Mark Hanson and his book *Faithful*, *yet Changing: The Church in Challenging Times*. While this material will serve as our guide, our preaching, teaching, and conversation will be contextually apropos for our community together at Morning Star. In other words, we will explore together what it means to be faithful and *Share the Light of Christ with All Creation* right here from the heart of Omaha, Nebraska!

I know how difficult it sometimes is to commit to and participate in the full breadth and depth of a Lenten journey, if not the ministry of the church itself. Yes, times have changed! But I also know something about what it means



to be faithful when schedules are full, kids have activities and homework, and sometimes it's just nice to have a break! Because of these dynamics, we are increasing our worship opportunities this year to include Lenten worship at noon. Bring your own lunch and eat it with us in our Gathering Space before or after our 30-minute worship services!

We have also adjusted our schedule in the evenings to accommodate those who would like to be home sooner. Our meal and fellowship times will be from 5:00-6:00, including our Confirmation mentoring and meal discussions. Our Holden Evening Prayer worship service will begin at 6:00 and conclude by 6:30. For those who would like to remain and participate in adult faith formation, there will be an additional book study. Please see more details about the book study in Pastor Glenn's newsletter article.

In closing, I want to express my gratitude for your faithfulness to the Gospel. I know these are challenging days. But the future is exciting, and *this is the time!* It's God's time and He is doing something new for each one of us.

Message from Pastor Glenn





Hey Kids! We would love to have you join us at 9:30 AM on Sundays for music, movement, kid-style fellow-


