Speaking of new beginnings, I am ever hopeful for our ministry together at Morning Star. This past December the congregation made a convincing decision about its mission as it moves into the future. You voted decisively to advance an exciting and much needed building project.

This *Enlighten Project*, as has been named, aims to transform our worship, gathering, and administrative spaces. Much of this project will also address several other urgent areas of deferred maintenance. All aspects of this project are inherently necessary as we look to be great stewards of our facility and our ministry together for several years to come and for generations yet unborn.

As such, I am pleased to report that this Enlighten Project has begun! For the next eleven months, you will witness an exciting transformation. We will also witness the reality of change through several stages of construction.

As your pastor, I understand there may be a range of thoughts and emotions a project like this one can have on a faith community. We are not naïve to think that everything will proceed without its challenges. After all, there are no quick fixes or easy answers when it comes to endeavors this transformative.

Yet, I believe the Holy Spirit is constantly at work renewing our strength as a worshipping community. As we begin this new chapter in the life of our congregation, I would like to invite you to consider three important ways you can help to lead us through this critical phase in the life of Morning Star.

First, please continue to join us for worship. Our primary mission is to share the Gospel through Word and Sacrament. This is foundational to who we are as a church. Second, please continue to support our congregation and its mission financially. Thank you to all who have completed a 2024 "Plan for Giving" card and those who continue to give of their God given treasures in support of Morning Star! I cannot emphasize enough how essential your stewardship is in supporting our mission of "Bringing the Light of Christ to ALL Creation."

Please keep in your prayers our ministry partners, including those people and organizations for whom our congregation's outreach efforts are crucial. Please pray for those involved in the process of leading us through the construction phase. This includes our architectural firm, BCDM and its staff, as well as our contractor, Boyd Jones and their affiliated staff and tradesmen. Please pray that we continue to be guided by the Holy Spirit in all the upcoming changes.

Finally, thank you for your faith and your witness to the Gospel during this time. Morning Star truly is a community grounded in God's grace and it is a privilege to serve alongside you always.



On weekends, when inclement weather affects the potential safety of worshippers traveling to and from church for worship, Pastor Chris and our Executive Committee will determine cancellation on an individual basis. Factors that affect these decisions include forecasted precipitation, hazardous road reports, extreme wind chill, and/or the ability to clear our parking lots and sidewalks of ice and snow for the safety of our worshippers and staff.

We will aim to communicate any worship cancellation at least two hours in advance by "robo" call to our membership as well with WOWT (Channel 6 online/ television).




