Late applications WILL NOT be considered.

Please be sure you have reviewed all eligibility requirements.

Scholarship recipients will receive a letter of acceptance in April or May 2020 and will be recognized during a Sunday Church service in June (date to be announced). It is expected you will attend. In addition, recipients must also contribute to a video which will be shown to the congregation during the Church recognition.

Morning Star members are blessed by the generosity of our donors and by the opportunity this scholarship gives for recognizing dedicated youth service to Morning Star Lutheran Church. Purpose:

- Recognize youth who have provided active service to support the community and programs of Morning Star Lutheran Church.
- Assist Morning Star high school graduates in their pursuit of post-secondary undergraduate studies.
- Award qualifying students with one year scholarships for up to four years maximum.

Eligibility:

- Must be a member of Morning Star Lutheran Church, which will include documented church service attendance during the calendar year prior to the award year.
- Must have a history of active service as a youth at Morning Star.
- Must pursue full-time study at an accredited post-secondary institution (minimum 12 hours per semester).
- Must graduate from high school with a minimum GPA of 2.5.
- Must maintain a minimum college GPA of 2.5 in order to be considered for recurring scholarship awards.
- Each school year is an independent decision and students must reapply.
- Recipients may receive no more than 4 individual annual scholarships.

Considerations:

- Preference is given to youth who serve the church as acolytes.
- Other service which supports the operation the church and church programs is also important. (Examples include lay reader, Sunday school assistant, special music, choir, usher.)
- Extended community service sponsored/organized by Morning Star directly, or through the Nebraska Synod, will also be considered

Dates:

- APPLICATIONS ARE DUE IN THE CHURCH OFFICE BY 4:30^{PM} ON March 1, 2020.. Applications received after the deadline date and time will *NOT* be considered.
- Awards are typically announced to the congregation in June.
- Applications will be available in the Church Office late November or Early December.
