Muzghan is enjoying these and has made remarkable progress as she has already advanced a level. The three daughters all love attending a local elementary school and are enjoying making new friends. The family particularly enjoys feeling safe in their new home. The Kawajazahda's have been attending worship in their mosque. I am proud of this congregation for showing your Christian love and support for people of the Muslim faith.

Habitat Faith Build Kick Off


The kick off was held June 8 with our own Francy Van Meter in attendance.


