Summer Sunday Service



Colleen Estee shared this with us recently at a worship service. What a beautiful thing to have experienced in that moment between Astronaut Buzz Aldrin and the Lord.

Buzz Aldrin took Holy Communion 50 years ago today, ON THE MOON. Aldrin silently read from John 15:5, which he penned on a 3-by-5-inch notecard, 'As Jesus said: I am the vine, you are the branches. Whoever remains in me, and I

in Him, will bear much fruit; for you can do nothing without me.' "In the radio blackout I opened the little plastic packages which contained bread and wine," Aldrin said. "I poured the wine into the chalice our church had given me. In the one-sixth gravity of the moon, the wine curled slowly and gracefully up the side of the cup. It was interesting to think that the very first liquid ever poured on the moon, and the first food eaten there, were communion elements."

Colleen's grandmother was Buzz's 2nd cousin, and her uncle, Wayne Sunblade, brother of former member Mildred Vaughn, was deeply involved in the Apollo 11 mission.




A very special thank you to Pastor Glenn Schacht for his role this summer while Pastor Chris was on sabbatical.

- Council approved a Job Description for a Director of Youth and Faith Formation who will coordinate and promote youth faith formation programs and work across all of our generations to support our faith journey. The next step in this exciting effort is to focus on how we may fund and implement this important element of our Strategic Plan.
- Council approved a two-prong initiative from our Outreach Committee to (i) support homeless Veterans in our community; and (ii) to provide additional assistance to our sponsored refugee family aimed at providing a bridge to self-sustainability. The initiative would be implemented through a grant from Immanuel Foundation being pursued by the Outreach Committee.
- Ric Miller delivered a report on the Nebraska Synod Assembly attended by our dedicated representatives Ric, Kyle & Ariel Wolfe. One (of the many) takeaways was the Bishop's view of a congregation with vitality: (i) people growing in spirituality; (ii) the existence of a defined purpose or plan; (iii) a congregational support and pursuit of that purpose/plan; and (iv) shared leadership. We hope and believe you see Morning Star in that definition!

ability to pay. In place of a bill, patrons are asked to pay what they are able through monetary donations or through the giving of their time. More than a meal, the cafe's connection with its patrons often goes beyond food. A 10-day training program is available to community members who are experiencing homelessness or are seeking to re-enter the workforce but lack the job skills or training.

They are planning to do even more—provide more healthy meals and serve even more people through their jobtraining program. 
