





Dear Morning Star Family,

This past summer was a gift. The opportunity to take a much needed ten-week sabbatical was one of the most wonderful things I have ever done in my years of ministry. This was important in several ways that I would like to articulate with you below. Please know that I do so in the context of tremendous appreciation for such a meaningful experience.

Thank you to the congregation for allowing me to be absent and for respecting the boundaries of this time and space. Thank you to our leadership, staff, and especially Pastor Glenn for all of their faithfulness, creativity, and hard work during this time. Because of this quite capable leadership, I was able to be gone and 'let go' trusting that our mission and ministry would function well. It did! This was one of the healthiest gifts you could have given your pastor and I am exceptionally thankful for allowing me to be on sabbatical.

I am thankful for this time of prayer and reflection. To be able to evaluate my pastoral leadership and reflect on my call at Morning Star came at an important juncture, entering my seventh year of ministry with you. Because of this intentional reflection, Morning Star was in my prayers daily. It always is. But now, as I return to you, I feel guided and empowered by the Spirit to continue building upon my pastoral relationship with you and several new members and families who have recently joined our congregation.

We are also discerning the addition of a new staff position to minister to our youth and assist in the leadership of Faith Formation ministry from cradle to grave. I am also excited about an upcoming fall emphasis on discipleship and for important congregational reflection on our recent Mission Goals. I return with newfound energy and imagination to help lead and partner in ministry with you in these ways.

I am thankful for this sabbatical as a time of rest. It is called "sabbatical" for a reason as it affords pastors with space to recharge physically, emotionally, and spiritually. As I worked to create healthier personal patterns in body, mind, and spirit, I recognized this time as a significant one in helping me to be a better husband, father, and disciple. It will be important for me moving forward in ministry to continue to incorporate some of these healthy patterns into my ministry to be the best role model and steward of the gifts God has given to me.

I am thankful for this time of study. I feel like I have unpacked a completely new world of learning and leadership as a result of my time studying Family Systems Theory. My learning and reflection in this area has not concluded, but rather will be a life-long endeavor as I seek to incorporate this learning into my ministry and life. This time of study is transforming how I see my own functioning and leadership in the midst of our congregation.

Most importantly, I am thankful for this sabbatical as a time to focus on my family. In particular, as my children were home for the summer, I was able to afford an entire season of time dedicated exclusively to them without any of the myriad demands of pastoral ministry. As a result, we created memories that will span our lifetimes. We all cherished the precious time I had in this regard. Just don't ask me or my boys to give up our new favorite fishing hole!

Thank you, Morning Star, for all of the ways in which you provided this gift to my family and to our partnership in ministry together!

The Church Office & Preschool will be closed Monday, September 2 for Labor Day!


Labor Day Weekend will have worship services at 5:30 ^{PM} on Saturday and 9:30 ^{AM} on Sunday.






