COVID-19 UPDATE

In an ongoing effort to keep our worshipping community safe, we continue to monitor the infection rate in Douglas County. Thank you to our Covid-19 Task Force for helping to evaluate worship and provide recommendations for gathering safely and providing protocols that decline the risk of infection. Thank you for your cooperation in wearing masks, social distancing, and hand hygiene during your time in worship.

If you are experiencing any symptoms known to be related to Covid-19 we ask that you refrain from public worship and join us online at home. If you are in one of the identified "high risk" categories as defined by the CDC and/or the Douglas County Health Department, we ask that you please consider worshipping online, if possible.

Due to a substantial infection increase in Omaha in the past few weeks, we ask that all worshippers self-monitor for symptoms and discern your risk of gathering in a community setting. We are in need of Greeters/Ushers for our worship services each week. If you would like to receive brief training on how to serve this way, contact Pastor Glenn at 402-393-5553.


