

Due to increased possible risk of acquisition and transmission of the Delta variant (the predominant strain in Nebraska) even amongst the vaccinated, combined with the updated <a href="CDC guidance for mask use">CDC guidance for mask use</a> amongst the vaccinated in public places, updated recommendations are needed to optimize the protection of our congregation, staff and students during this evolving phase of the pandemic. These changes are important particularly to reduce transmission of the Delta variant those who are unvaccinated, the under vaccinated (such as the immunocompromised or older persons in which a vaccine may be suboptimal) or those who have high-risk family members at home or family members, such as children, who cannot be vaccinated.

The COVID Task Force is recommending the following changes in order to maintain the safe environment that we have established here:

- Masks/face coverings are required for entering the building.
- Seating in every other pew.
- Holy Communion will be received via prepackaged elements. Worshippers may come forward to the altar to receive the pre-sealed, non-alcohol elements and return to their seats or they may select one of the consecrated kits at the welcome table prior to worship.
- No coffee fellowship following worship.
- Groups using the church building can do so as long as they remain masked and socially distanced.



# ELCA's Disaster Response to Hurricane Ida

The devastation from Hurricane Ida, which made landfall near New Orleans on August 29, exactly 16 years after Hurricane Katrina, left homes flooded and residents awaiting rescue. Strong winds knocked out power lines and electrical substations, leaving more than 1 million people without power, including the entirety of New Orleans. Rebuilding will be costly and take years. Lutheran Disaster Response is working with local ELCA synods and social service organizations to coordinate a response to Hurricane Ida. Immediate needs include food, basic necessities and temporary housing. Long after the headlines change, Lutheran Disaster Response will continue to accompany communities on the journey of rebuilding their homes and lives. - The Council met on Saturday, September 11 for our regular council meeting and annual retreat.
- Membership for 18 individuals was approved by the Council. The new members were received and presented to the congregation at the September 12 service.
- The Council approved continuing with one Sunday morning service at 10 AM through the end of 2021.
- The stewardship campaign was approved by the Council. We ask for your continued support and giving, as you pray about your 2022 pledge.
- The Council approved a team for the building assessment process. This team will be working with the architect, HVAC, and electrical engineer for a comprehensive review of our facilities over the next couple of months. This project was approved by the congregation in June.
- After the Council meeting, we reviewed a framework for strategic planning. The
  Council is excited to begin this work with participation and input from the
  congregation. Part of the process includes bringing the congregation together
  for conversation and listening, which is difficult with COVID. We are hopeful
  that we can start this work in 2022.





Food4Friends is an original Morning Star ministry that provides a complete Thanksgiving dinner to the "working poor" families of the Omaha Metro area. Morning Star is able to deliver around 150 people a delicious meal during a time that can be financially taxing to families barely making ends meet.
