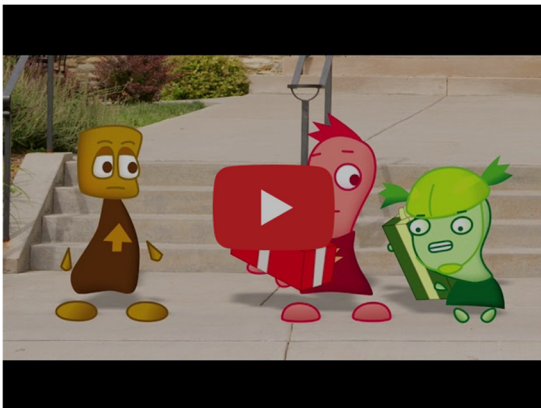


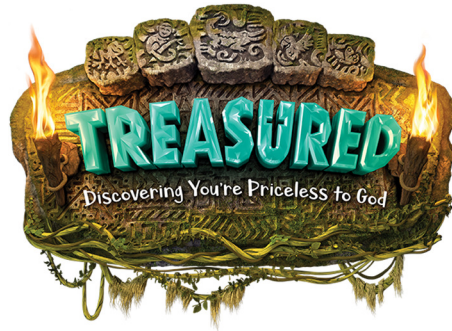

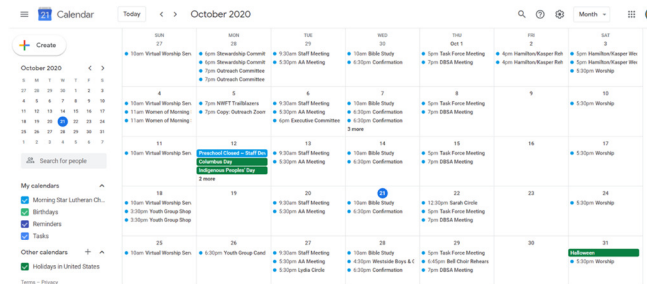
Council Highlights & CELEBRATION
