Morning Star Church Council Highlights:

A primary focus of our May Council Meeting was when and how we should again gather inside our beautiful church building to Worship together. Our Council includes three persons working in the healthcare sector that have valuable expertise, insight and information. We are blessed that the remaining Council Members are exceptionally skilled thinkers with excellent judgment.

We of course are guided by the shared commitment to our faith and the strong desire to gather with you to Worship and share in Fellowship. And, we are again reminded of Paul's admonition:

So then, whenever we have an opportunity, let us work for the good of all, and especially for those of the family of faith. ~ Galatians 6:10

Given the significant current trend of increasing Covid-19 infections, hospitalizations and deaths in Douglas County, notwithstanding our legal entitlement to gather, Council decided

that, for the good of our family of faith, it would not be prudent to do so at this time.

We are extremely encouraged by, and thankful for, the number of persons that are worshipping online and trust that will continue. We of course recognize and regret that not all have that ability.

With the generous and skilled leadership of Pastors Chris and Glenn, we are forming two task forces (including Congregation Members that have expertise with infectious diseases) to help us design a plan for determining how and when (i) we can first gather safely as a Congregation to share in Worship and Fellowship; and (ii) we can re-open our Preschool and Child Care Center.

We will work to keep you informed but please feel free to contact any Council Member with your questions or concerns.
