


Mid Week Update

his week marks three months since the bomb cyclone hit the Midwestern United States with its ccompanying blizzards and floods. Earlier this week, a person in Fremont shared with rustration, "Some people think disaster work is done."

Disaster work in fact is not done, but it has changed from immediate disaster response to longerm disaster recovery, and recovery work will be going on for four to five more years. How can

ou be involved in these efforts?

ong-term disaster recovery groups are currently at various stages of being formed, and their rork will in most cases include case management, construction management, and volunteer oordination. These teams are largely made up of volunteers who work together to serve their eighbors impacted by the disaster, and teams are currently in the following Nebraska ounties: Antelope, Buffalo, Burt, Cass, Cuming, Custer, Dodge, Douglas, Hall, Knox, Madison, ierce, Platte, Sarpy, Stanton, Thurston, and Washington.




