Al-Anon is a group for those who are worried about someone with drinking problems. An Al-Anon group meets at Morning Star on Wednesdays at Noon.








If you've ever been at the church on a Thursday night, you've run into the DBSA, Depression, Bi-Polar Support Alliance. They meet at Morning Star every week
