Dedication

October 12

On Sunday, October 12, we will have a Service of Dedication for our now completed Enlighten Project. Weather pending, we will gather outdoors in Morning Star's glorious new Prayer Garden. From pavement to altar, we will humbly ask God's blessings upon this glorious new remodel of God's house. As we enter through the doors of the church, we will not just delight in the beauty of fresh

new walls and fixtures but rather delight in God's eternal and gracious presence.

Fittingly, we will begin our time of worship together in prayer. We will pray that Morning Star continues to

be a sacred space for all of God's children to gather. We will pray that every square inch of our building and grounds be a place for proclaiming God's Word. We will pray that our campus continues to provide a place that brings life and hope to us and the community we serve. We will pray for generations yet unborn to be touched by a building that literally shares the Gospel as it shines on its walls.

I trust we will not forget the reason our congregation made the courageous for the Holy Spirit to continue to do its decision to embark on this exciting project. > signaled the reunification of those from different regions and languages that suddenly understood one common reality...the power of God in Spirit!

For these reasons, red is typically only seen in

worship on Pentecost Sunday and Reformation Sunday, days that celebrate the church. Fittingly, it's also the color used in worship during a Service of Dedication. May the color red signal a Spirit that moves us beyond our comfort zones and into the redzones of ministry. These are the zones where we are called to push the envelope of what we imagine is humanly possible, but which God makes happen. So, wear red to worship on this day as we pray work through our new space and each one of us!

I invite you and anyone you can invite to attend worship on this sacred and powerful day of ministry. Following worship, we will convene downstairs in our Fellowship Hall for a catered lunch. This will not only be a time of fellowship, but a time to reflect on the wonderful history of our beloved congregation. All we ask is that you please confirm you and/or your family's attendance. Information

about our menu with an opportunity to RSVP for this free meal will be forthcoming very soon.

In the meantime, I want to share a word of appreciation and gratitude for each of you. Thank you for your continued openness to the Holy Spirit. Thank you for being a partner in listening to the ways God has been calling us as a community to serve and urgently share the story of salvation. 

The DBSA (Depression, BiPolar Support Alliance) meets at Morning Star Thursdays at 7 PM. This meeting is open to anyone in need!


