## PARENT \& STUDENT BUS STOP RULES \& PROCEDURES

## Student Bus Safety Rules

Be respectful to the bus driver and the other passengers.
Enter the bus orderly, Take your assigned seat quickly.
Wear your seat belt until you get off the bus.
Face forward \& stay seated while the bus is moving.
Talk with an inside voice to the person next to you.
The use of profanity is strictly forbidden on bus.
Keep your hands, Feet \& all belongings out of aisle.
No play fighting, hitting, or kicking each other at any time.
Eating, Drinking or Chewing Gum is not allowed on the bus.
Cell phones, Tablets \& Electronic device use is not allowed.
Be quite at all railroad crossings until you hear the beep.
Always follow the directions of the driver.

## Parent Bus Stop Safety Procedures and Responsibilities for Students Being Transported

Arrive at the bus stop Ten (10) Minutes prior to the scheduled pickup time in the morning and afternoon.
Allow the driver to be Ten (10) Minutes after the schedules stop time before you call in to check the status of the bus due to road, traffic \& weather conditions.

Take responsibility for the behavior \& conduct of you student while waiting for the bus to arrive.
Instruct the student to wait for the bus to come to a complete stop before attempting to get on or off the bus.
Instruct student to enter and exit the bus at the front door unless otherwise directed by the driver in case of emergency.

Instruct the student to not tamper with windows, door handles and other safety equipment.
Anyone authorized to pick up a Kindergarten student must present valid driver's always license or identification card and must be 16 years old or older.

Instruct your student to only use their wireless device in case of emergencies only defined as bus accident $\mathbf{3 0}$ minutes delays in the route for mechanical breakdowns.
