Current Status

We have incorporated as Follow the Yellow Brick Road, Inc., and are working on our application for 501c3 non-profit status with the IRS, and non-taxed not for profit status with the state.

Kathryn will be working with us throughout the remainder of the convention planning process and the convention itself.
