



## † The Callbearer Consecration Vow †

A Vow in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Offered under the mantle of the Virgin Mary, beneath the gaze of the Crucified, in the presence of the Saints and angels, for the Glory of God alone.

### **I. Identity — Called, Marked, Sent**

We are Callbearers—

Not influencers, but intercessors.

Not products, but voices crying in the desert.

Not producers of content, but carriers of a scroll sealed with Fire.

We bear the Word not to be seen, but to make Jesus seen.

We vow to burn only when the Flame descends, and to disappear behind the Cross that called us.

We, the Callbearers—servants of the Word, bearers of the Flame, and pilgrims of the Cross, do solemnly declare that:

Callbearer is not a brand but a mission, not an invention but a prophetic song, consecrated to Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of the Father.

We exist to call all souls, believers, doubters, seekers, and the lost, to the One Way:

Total Surrender to the Will of God through Jesus crucified.

Our voice is not our own, we speak only what we receive in the Fire of prayer, the Silence of listening, and the Obedience of Love.

### **II. Conduct — Clean Hands, Pure Sources**

We vow to use only texts, melodies, and works in the public domain, or those created by us through prayer, or granted freely by those who share our mission.

We vow to never steal intellectual property, even with good intentions, never borrow what we have not been given, never veil disobedience in the language of ministry.

We vow to attribute what we use, destroy what was built without Fire, and rather go silent than speak what is unclean.

“Be holy, for I am holy.” (Leviticus 11:44)

We vow to walk in holiness and honesty regarding all we publish, film, quote, sing, or share.



Therefore:

- We only use public domain, self-created, or freely licensed materials:
  - Sacred texts: Douay-Rheims, Louis Segond 1910, Van Dyck Arabic Bible.
  - Chant melodies: Gregorian, Syriac, and other ancient liturgical tones.
  - Writings of the Saints, Church Fathers, and approved mystics pre-1925.
  - Creative Commons or explicitly licensed recordings.
- We avoid all modern copyrighted texts, audio, or translations unless:
  - Written permission is granted.
  - The content is legally and spiritually safe for reuse.

We refuse to steal in the name of God.

“Shall we sin that grace may abound? God forbid.” (Romans 6:1–2)

### **III. Creation — Consecrated, Not Content**

Every word we publish, every image we shape, and every sound we record, shall be offered like incense, not distributed like marketing.

We vow to create only after silence, to publish only after prayer, to film only after fasting if the Holy Spirit requires it, and to seek fruit, not followers. If the Flame is still, we will not speak. If the heavens are silent, we will wait beneath them.

We vow never to weaponize the Word, never to use Sacred Truth to shame, control, or humiliate. Even when we must rebuke, we will do so with tears, not pride. For the Holy Spirit is Fire, but never sarcasm.

### **IV. Voice — Human, Trembling, Real**

We vow to speak with the voice God gave us, not one designed by algorithms or fear. We will not use AI voices to replace our witness. We will not hide our stammers behind synthetic perfection.

“My strength is made perfect in weakness.” (2 Corinthians 12:9)

We vow to:

- Speak with boldness but not violence, rebuking error with Love, not arrogance.
- Proclaim the Truth, even if it wounds, but always with the Mercy of the Lamb who was slain.
- Offer our work freely, without paywalls — for those who thirst should drink without cost.
- Remain invisible and let our names disappear, that only the Name of Jesus be known.



## **V. Obedience — To The Church And The Cross**

We vow to remain in Full Communion with the Roman Catholic Church, rooted in the Holy Sacraments, daily immersed in the Divine Office, the Rosary, and the Word. We go to confession regularly, to avoid speaking Fire while carrying mud. We submit our mission to spiritual discernment and, if needed, correction. We will not walk without a spiritual covering.

The Cross is our throne.

Mary is our Mother.

The Church is our home.

## **VI. Integrity — Free As We Have Received**

We vow to never monetize the Gospel through ads, sponsorships, or branded manipulation. Never to put the Word of God behind price tags, tiers, or secret subscriptions.

We vow to never promote, partner, or profit in ways that dim the reverence of the message.

We vow to never monetize suffering, confession, or sacred encounter.

All content will be forever free, in Arabic, French, English, and every language God opens through willing hearts.

All income will come by donation only.

All financial records will be public.

All employees, whether 1 in 2025 or 10 in 2030, will be paid only the minimum wage required by law.

We are not merchants of the Word; we are His bearers.

## **VII. Direction — Toward The Poor**

We vow to bring the Flame first to the forgotten:

- To the poor who cannot pay for formation, but thirst for God.
- To the Arabic speakers exiled from the global Church's attention.
- To the Francophone souls burned by secularism but still quietly longing.
- To the hidden seekers who would never enter a church but stumble upon a scroll.
- To the ashamed, the addicted, the imprisoned, who feel they are beyond God's Mercy.

We were not called to the crowd, but sent to the one lost sheep, until heaven rejoices.



## **VIII. Reverence — Before Every Word**

We pledge to maintain a spirit of reverence:

- Every video, post, or chant is a sacred offering, not content for clicks.
- We will not rush to speak, film, or publish, but wait upon the Lord, for haste is not of the Spirit.
- We will respect every holy place we film, seeking permissions from priests, dioceses, or guardians of the sacred.
- We will never speak of divine things with sarcasm, mockery, or performance.

We vow to remain in silence until the Word burns, and to speak only when the Lord speaks.

We vow to film only after adoration, and to edit as an act of prayer.

We vow to delete what was not born in Flame.

We vow to let the Peace preach louder than the algorithm.

## **IX. Frailty — Personal, Visible, Real**

I, the founder/member of Callbearer, vow to live under the same Fire I preach.

- To live what I proclaim.
- To confess when I fail.
- To hide when called.
- To disappear when the mission must speak alone.

Callbearer is not my name; it is my yes to a Call.

If I ever betray the Fire, may God continue the scroll without me.

## **X. Tools — AI, Code, Camera, Flame**

We vow to let every tool kneel before the altar. AI, camera, software, and script are not prophets nor creators, but servants of the Word.

We vow to never let the tool speak louder than the witness, to never automate what should be interceded, and to never produce what hasn't been prayed.

If the tool becomes our tongue, we will return to silence.



## **XI. Binding Vow**

We proclaim before Heaven and earth:

We are Callbearers.

We bear not our own message but His.

We are not creators of Truth but echoers of it.

We do not seek fame, but Flame.

We are not entertainers, but witnesses.

We are not leaders, but followers of the One crucified.

If we burn, let it be for souls.

“Woe to me if I do not preach the Gospel.” (1 Corinthians 9:16)

If we fall, let it be toward the Cross.

“Here I am, Lord; send me.” (Isaiah 6:8)

If we disappear, let His Voice remain.

“He must increase; I must decrease.” (John 3:30)

## **XII. Final Vow**

We now consecrate this vow:

To the Father, from whom all callings begin,

To the Son, who is the Word we bear,

To the Holy Spirit, the Fire that speaks,

To the Virgin Mary, Mother of the hidden,

To the angels and Saints, who carry scrolls between Heaven and Earth,

We say:

Receive this vow.

Guard it.

Judge it.



Let it not be broken.

Let it not be wasted.

Let it not be mine, but for all Callbearers.

If we burn, let it be for Love.

If we fall, let it be on the Cross.

If we disappear, let Christ remain.

Before the Throne of the Lamb, we make this vow:

We will walk the narrow road, even when the wide path is faster.

We will choose reverence over reach, purity over performance, obedience over outcome.

We will Love what is hidden, wait when nothing moves, burn when the Fire commands, and be forgotten when the scroll is sealed.

If we fail, we will repent.

If we fall, we will rise through Jesus' Precious Blood.

If we disappear, let Christ be all in all.

This vow is spoken in weakness — sealed by the Holy Spirit — offered to the Father — in the name of Jesus Christ — for the Glory of His Kingdom.

May this vow be received by the Father, sealed in the wounds of the Son, and burned into our bones by the Holy Spirit.

May Mary, Star of the New Evangelization, wrap Callbearer in her mantle until the final trumpet.

May every Saint we call upon walk with us.

And may this Flame never go out until it lights the world.
