This does not yet include my achievements as a child in sports and recreation and civil roles. Take responsibility as young as you can. At junior school I was a Milk Monitor, a aviary keeper, RSPB card holder, school dog handler and a Tuck Shop Keeper. I also passed grade 6 gymnastics, won swimming galas and sports days. By the time of my last senior school, I was a stage manager and sound technician to the school. Also missing from here are my Sales and Marketing Management (ISMM), Chartered Institute for Personnel Development (CIPD), Martial Arts and other qualifications. This was because oppressive people destroyed my life and property, because 'I' let them. The learning was to 'get the losers out of your life' (Les Brown quote). My advice about people who sound like that. Don't go back. You have left. Make peace with any cultural obligations that impress on you and assert boundaries with others that let them know, your strength has an equal outcome, should they pick at you. Their lesson ought to be, to discover the reasons you would stay in touch with them. It's an astonishing fact, most murder victims knew their murderer and let them into the safe space where they were killed. Muse that. It saved my life many times, for they hate what you are, and if that is love, it is because your love is intoxicating.

Tips on how to handle 'them';

- **Psychologically refuse to rent free space in your head, on social media or in your material life.**
- **Assert that you mean to have no further contact because you do not have the time or energy to fix them. Admit you are not competent in their needs. You will not be training to assist them dwell in a stagnant state. Show you are free.**
- **Get injunctions and use public services to let them know, as your mediator, you have equal rights to protection. They do not have power over you or in your life without invitation or agreement.**
- **Quit melting your own thinking that it is your problem. You did not give them that attitude or way of life. Your work is to bring the gifts you were given to present to this world and no one else can do that.**
- **Don't talk if you don't want to. Talking is not a proven and effective means to healing. Sometimes other action gets you to safety and self-harmony first. You know yourself; you are responsible for yourself; their guilt is their problem. Your free gift is freedom.**

Start somewhere, whenever, and wherever. I remembered it all and left none of my learning behind. Others may make you think small, if you let them. Therefore, don't tell them everything until you are ready to show your true colours, and that is when it matters to you and your team.

Praise is not as equivalent to accreditation. Accreditation is evidential.' And 'Love is honest', quote me.
