

HOW TO USE THESE PRAYERS

At least two people are required one to lead and the other to provide the responses in colour or bold lettering. You may also need the Divine Mercy Chaplet which includes the short daily 9-day novena. It is suitable for classes, bigger groups and on missions or day trips too.

These can be read at any hour of the day, but it is recommended that no matter where you are in the world at 3pm you arrive at the 3 O'clock prayer to join all in your country or around the world in a spiritual uniting of prayer.

PRAYERS TO DIVINE MERCY

***In the Name of the Father and of the Son
and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.†***

**Opening Prayer as written by the Prayer Lead of St
Saviours Divine Mercy Shrine, John Martin**

We offer our prayers up today, through the intercession of our Blessed Mother, to Jesus the Divine Mercy, the Divine Son, the Divine Saviour, for the health and welfare of our beloved Holy Father, for peace in the church peace in the world, peace in our minds, hearts and souls; peace and reconciliation between all members of families, for intentions of all those here present today, for those who cannot be with us today, for those who may join us at any time, for the protection of the child in the womb, for persecuted Christians around world and for unfortunate people in the countries where terrible atrocities are taking place, as we say...

1. THE MEMORARE OF ST BERNARD

Remember O Most Gracious Virgin Mary that never was it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help or sought thy intercession was left unaided.

Inspired by this confidence I fly unto thee O Virgin of Virgins My Mother

**To thee do I come, before thee I kneel sinful
and sorrowful. O Mother of the Word
Incarnate despise not my petitions but in thy
clemency hear and answer me. Amen.**

2. APOSTLES OF MERCY PRAYER

**Merciful Jesus we believe in you and we trust
in you. Come to the aid of our weakness and
incapacity. Grant that we may be able to make
you know and loved by all. And confident in
the immensity of your love we may be able to
combat the evil which is in us and all of the
world for your glory and our salvation. Amen.**

3. OUR DAILY PRAYERS TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

**O Holy Spirit I humbly implore you, be with me
always, so that in all things I may act only under
the influence of your Holy Inspirations.**

**O Mary by thy pure and immaculate Conception
make my body pure and my soul holy.**

Holy Spirit, you resolve all problems, light all roads so that I can attain my goal. You gave me the divine gift to forgive and forget all offenses against me and in all instance of my life you are with me.

I want in this short prayer to thank you for all the things as you confirm once again that I never want to be separated from you, even in spite of all material illusion.

I wish to be with you in eternal glory and I thank you for your mercy towards me and mine.

Come Holy Spirit and fill the hearts of the faithful; enkindle them in the fire of your love.

Send forth your spirit and they shall be created and thou shall renew the face of the earth.

O God, on the first Pentecost you instructed the hearts of those who believed in you by the light of the Holy Spirit.

Under the same inspiration of the same spirit, give us a taste for what is right and true and a

continuing sense of His presence and power.
Through Jesus Christ Our Lord. **Amen.**



4. DIVINE MERCY CONVERSION PRAYER

The prayer most pleasing to me is the prayer for conversion. Know my daughter this prayer is always heard and answered. Jesus said: "I

desire to know more profoundly the love that burns in my heart for souls and you will understand when you meditate upon my passion.”

“Call upon my Mercy on behalf of sinners. I desire their salvation. When you say this prayer with a contrite heart and faith on the part of some sinner I will give that soul the grace of conversion”.

(Here let us think about of somebody we wish to pray for, maybe somebody who is particularly close to us, somebody who has been away for the sacrament of reconciliation for a long time or somebody who has been away from mass for a long time).

This is the prayer: **O blood and water which gushed forth from the heart of Jesus as a fount of Mercy for us I trust in you. (Repeat 3 times)**

5. Oh my Jesus, I beg you on behalf of the whole church, grant it the love and light of your Spirit.

Give power to the words of priests so that gardened hearts may be bought to repentance and return to you.

Lord, give us Holy priests, you yourself maintain them in holiness.

O Divine and Great High Priest, may the power of your mercy accompany them everywhere.

And protect them from the devils traps and snares which are continually being set for the souls of priests.

May the power of you mercy O Lord, shatter and bring to nought all that might tarnish the sanctity of a priest for you can do all things.

Amen.

6. PRAYER TO BE MERCIFUL – LOVE ONE ANOTHER AS I HAVE LOVED YOU

Help me Jesus, that what I ask of you (Mercy) I will give to others in word and deed.

Help me O Lord that my eyes may be merciful so that I never suspect or judge others, but always look for what is beautiful and good in other people.

Help me O Lord that my eyes might be merciful so that I may give heed to others and not be indifferent to their pain.

Help me O Lord that my tongue may be merciful so that I should never speak wrongly of others, but have a word of comfort and forgiveness for all.

Help me O Lord that my hands might be merciful and filled with good deeds, so that I may only do good for others and always try to take upon myself the more difficult tasks.

Help me O Lord that my feet might be merciful
so that I might hurry to assist others,
overcoming my own fatigue and weariness,
contemplating your love and mercy.

Help me O Lord to forgive and forget. This is
your greatest gift to me and should be mine for
sake of all those who offend me.

And that no relapse, no matter how shameful or criminal, should allow the sinner to despair of your forgiveness. I have offended you O beloved Redeemer, but it would be worse still if I were to

offend you by thinking that you were lacking in goodness to forgive me.

I would rather be deprived of everything else that I have than the trust I have in your Mercy. Should I fall a hundred times or should my crimes be a hundred times worse than they actually are, I would continue to trust in your Mercy.

9. PRAYER FOR MERCY FOR THE DYING

O Merciful Jesus, lover of souls, I beseech you by the agony of Your Most Sacred Heart, and by the sorrows of your Immaculate Mother.

Wash clean in the blood the sinners of the whole world who are now in their final agony but especially those on their way to damnation and about to die this day.

Heart of Jesus who suffered death's agony, I beg you to have mercy on these poor souls.

10. PRAYER FOR MERCY FOR SOULS IN PURGATORY

Eternal Father, I offer you the most precious blood of your divine son, Jesus, in union with all the masses said throughout the world today, for all the Holy Souls in purgatory, for sinners everywhere, for sinners in the universal church, for those in my own home and within my own family. **Amen.**

11. DIVINE MERCY PRAYER FOR HOMELESS CHILDREN

Eternal Father reach out with your tender love and mercy to those pitiful children who wander the streets at night.

With your unfathomable love and mercy bring them back to their families or to a home you choose for them.

Holy Spirit lead many to reach out in love to poor children in distress.

Jesus through Your Divine Mercy enable us to help these poor children in distress.

Mother Mary, send out your mother's love to these poor children who have never known the love and tenderness of an earthly mother.

We unite this prayer with all the prayers of Divine Mercy, offered to the Eternal Father this day, for the lonely, distressed and homeless children and the people of the world.

Through Christ Our Lord. Amen.

12. PRAYER FOR THE RELEASE OF A LOVED ONE FROM ALCOHOL OR DRUG ADDICTION OR ANY FORM OF ADDICTION THROUGH THE DIVINE MERCY AND BLOOD OF JESUS

Lord Jesus, I put myself into your hands this day.
I ask you with all my heart to cure the terrible

addiction to alcohol/drugs and all forms of addiction.

(Here we think of some people that may be very close to us that we wish to pray for)

Create in them an intolerance for alcohol, drugs and all forms of addiction, that will prevent them from ever offending those who love them again.

Grant that their loved ones the grace to forgive them for all the hurt that they have caused through the Divine Mercy and Blood of Jesus. I also pray that they will be healed of all withdrawal symptoms of this terrible affliction.

I sincerely ask this in the Name of Jesus. **Amen.**

13.DIVINE MERCY PRAYER FOR THE PHYSICALLY AND SEXUALLY ABUSED.

Divine Mercy, I beg you to protect those helpless children who are physically and sexually abused, especially by those who's duty it is to guide and protect them on earth.

Send down your enveloping Cloak of Mercy and wrap it around these poor children and enfold them in your love and protection.

Send forth your rays of blood and water to cleanse and renew the souls of those who perpetrate these vile acts of Satan.

Let there be a way to get your powerful image of Divine Mercy into the homes of these sad families, from where graces will flow as you promised and they shall be renewed.

O Blood and Water which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a Fount of mercy for us, I

Strengthen them for service of those in need as you prepare them to reflect Your Mercy.

Lord Jesus, call many generous souls to your service and transform them into living reflections of your Mercy.

Lord Jesus, call many generous souls to your service and transform them into ministers of your Mercy, for you can do all things.

20.DIVINE MERCY PRYARE FOR ALL MANKIND BUT ESPECIALLY FOR SINNERS

Most merciful Jesus whose very nature it is to have compassion and forgive us. Do not look upon the trust we place in your infinite goodness. We beg you to turn your merciful gaze on all mankind and especially upon poor sinners.

Enfold them in your most compassionate heart that we may praise the infinite power of your goodness forever.

Amen.

21.WE PRAY NOW FOR THE HOLY SOULS IN PURGATORY

O My God, I offer thee every thought, word and deed of the day now beginning for the poor suffering souls in purgatory.

My rising and laying down, my going out and coming in, my work and recreation, my sorrows and my delights, my successes and my disappointments, my good fortune and mishaps, my gains and my losses, my pleasures and pains, all I may do, say or feel.

Beseeching thee that through the infinite merits of the passion of thy Divine Son, to which I unite all my works, that these poor souls be seedily released from their dolorous pains, to see love and enjoy thee forever.

**22.AND AROUND THE WORLD RIGHT AT THIS
MOMENT IN TIME MANY MASSES ARE BEING
CELEBRATED SO WE OFFER THIS PRAYER UP
FOR THE DYING.**

My God, I offer all the masses which are being celebrated today throughout the world, for sinners who are in their agony and about to die this day.

May the precious blood of Jesus obtain mercy for them from a sudden and unprovided death.

O'Lord deliver us.

O Lord God Almighty, I pray you, by the precious blood which gushed forth from the side of thy Divine Son Jesus, in the sight of and to the most extreme pain of His Most Holy Mother; deliver the souls in purgatory and especially the one whom is most devout to Her.

23. PRAYER FOR DECEASED PERSONS BY NAME

(Here we remember our own parents, relatives and friends, our ancestors and all those people who have died suddenly unprepared)

O Jesus, only hope of the sinner, remember that when burdened with the cross you painfully climbed the Hill of Calvary, leaving your footsteps marked with your blood.

You thought of the salvation of our souls and among them the souls of your servants.

Remember that when left nailed to the infamous cross, you offered yourself as a pure and generous victim, to obtain for us the grace of repentance and pardon.

Restore on your servants, we pray, the fruit of your love and mercy.

With hearts full of sincere sorrow we kneel at
the foot of the cross and pray you to receive us
as a father full of pity and goodness.

24.WE CONTINUE NOW WITH OUR PRAYERS OF HEALING

Slow me down Lord and ease the pounding of my heart
with the quieting of my mind.

Let me look upward to the towering oak and know that it grew great and strong because it grew slowly and well.

25.WE PRAY NOW OUR HEALING PRAYER A PRAYER THAT IS SAID AT BEDTIME AND DURING THE DAY.

Which we offer up for all those here present and who are hurt, who are suffering, and those who are in pain, and we keep in mind those who are seriously ill and awaiting results of tests, and those who have left petitions in the Petition Book at the foot of the image of the Divine mercy.

Accept all these petitions dear Jesus and hand them to our Father in Heaven that he may hold them close to his heart.

Jesus, through the power of the Holy Spirit go back in my memory as I sleep.

Every hurt that has been done to me, **...heal that hurt.**

Every hurt that I have ever caused to another person,

...heal those relationships.

But Lord, if there anything that I need to do, If I need to go to a person because they are still suffering at my hand.

...bring to my awareness that person.

I choose to forgive and I ask to be forgiven. Remove whatever bitterness that may be in my heart Lord and fill the empty spaces with your Love. **Thank you Jesus**

26.THE THREE O'CLOCK PRAYER

Dear Jesus, dear Divine Mercy, you asked us to come to the fount of your mercy at this time and you promised that anyone who came to the fount of your Mercy would never go away empty handed.

We come to you with an open heart to receive all the graces and blessing that thou bestow upon each and everyone hear present, on those who join us spiritually in prayer,

For those who have asked us to pray for them,

For those who have written their petitions into the petition book at the image of the foot of the Divine Mercy.

(Thursdays only add 'For all those who have written petitions into the petition book at the foot of the Image of Divine Mercy that is now placed on the altar in the presence of Our Lord who is really truly present in the Most Blessed Sacrament').

We ask you dear Jesus to accept these petitions and hand them to the Father in Heaven so that he can hold them close to His Heart and with His smiling face, look down upon them.

And if it be the will of the Father in Heaven, let it be His will and not our will.

You expired Jesus but the source of life gushed forth for souls and an ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world.

**O' Fount of life, unfathomable Mercy Divine,
envelop the whole world and empty yourself
out upon us.**

**O' Blood and water which gushed forth from
the heart of Jesus as a fount of Mercy for us, I
trust in you (repeat 3 times).**

27.ST FAUSTINAS NOVENA TO THE DIVINE MERCY

We also pray that more and more priests will become involved in the Divine Mercy devotion, especially our Tuesday Night Devotions (at the Dominicans Church, St Saviours Dublin from 6.30pm).

We also offer this novena up to Jesus, the Divine Mercy, and to His Father in Heaven, in thanksgiving, through the intercessions of St Faustina, for all the graces and blessings that He has bestowed upon each and every one of us.

28.CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY

Which we offer up for the conversion of sinners
and for those who will die this day unprepared.

And we ask Jesus stand by the side of all those
who are dying at this moment.

Recite:

The Our Father

X1 Hail Mary

Apostles Creed

Divine Mercy decades

**One the large bead say “Eternal Father I offer
you the body and blood, soul and divinity of
your dearly beloved son, Our Lord Jesus Christ,
in atonement for our sins and the sins of the
whole world’**

One the small beads say “For the sake of His sorrowful passion” and respond with “for our sins and the sins of the whole world”

Conclude the 5th decade repeated 3 times with:

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, Have mercy on us and on the whole world.

29.WE PRAY NOW OUR PRAYERS FOR PYSCAL HEALING

And For a brief moment our own particular petitions as we hand them to Jesus so that He can hand them to Our Father in Heaven)

Jesus Son of David Have Mercy on Us

Jesus, your hands and feet were pierced,

Your side was pierced only that you might cure
us,

That you may heal the body which was created
as a temple of the Holy Spirit

Jesus, cure us by your patience and suffering

Cure the sick and their attendants of impatience

Heal our love so that we may bear pain as you
did.

Jesus Son of David Have Mercy on Us

Jesus, you accepted a crown of thorns on your
head, you received blows.

By your wounds and the crown of thorns, cure
us of every headache.

Jesus Son of David Have Mercy on Us

You closed your eyes in order to restore our
sight

Heal our eyes, restore sight to the blind.

Jesus Son of David Have Mercy on Us

Jesus, you were obedient to the Father,

You heard his word and you glorified Him with
your lips

Jesus restore our hearing and speech

Heal the deaf and the mute

Jesus Son of David Have Mercy on Us

Jesus by your pierced hands and feet, cure every
paralysis

Cure all the hands which are clenched into fists

Jesus Son of David Have Mercy on Us
