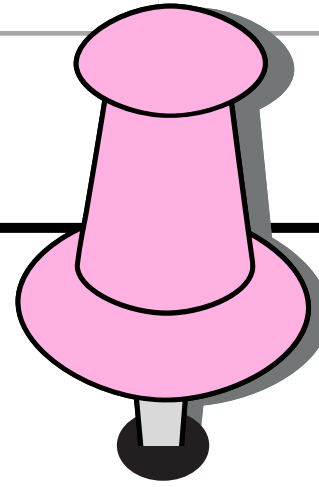
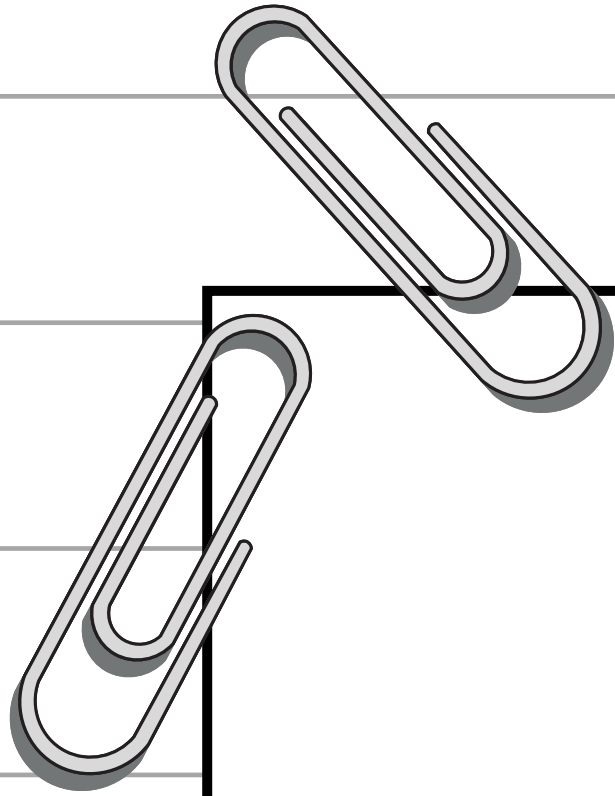

- 11.15am - Lunch begins; packed lunches and then school lunches
- 12.45pm - Afternoon snack begins
- 2.40pm - Tidy up time
- 2.45pm - Doors will open for parents/carers
- 3.00pm - Session ends

We have an open-door policy for all parents/carers to come speak to any member of staff. We can also make appointments if you would rather speak in private. Parents/carers can also collect their child whenever they wish. But we encourage to call the school/nursery to inform staff about this.



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Our Curriculum

Within the nursery we are very child-based, interested for our learning and development. Through conversations, inspiration, provocations and age and stage of development we plan for each of our children in the establishment. We have a very interdisciplinary style of learning for children who participate in multiple curricular areas through play.

Each member of staff will plan and prepare learning for their own zones. We have 4 zones within the nursery; Social, Creative, Discovery and Outdoor. We hold planning meetings fortnightly to ensure learning and development of skills are identified and supported.
