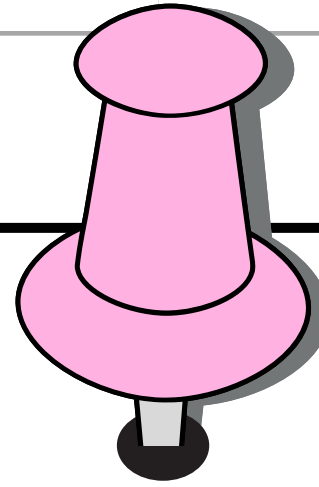
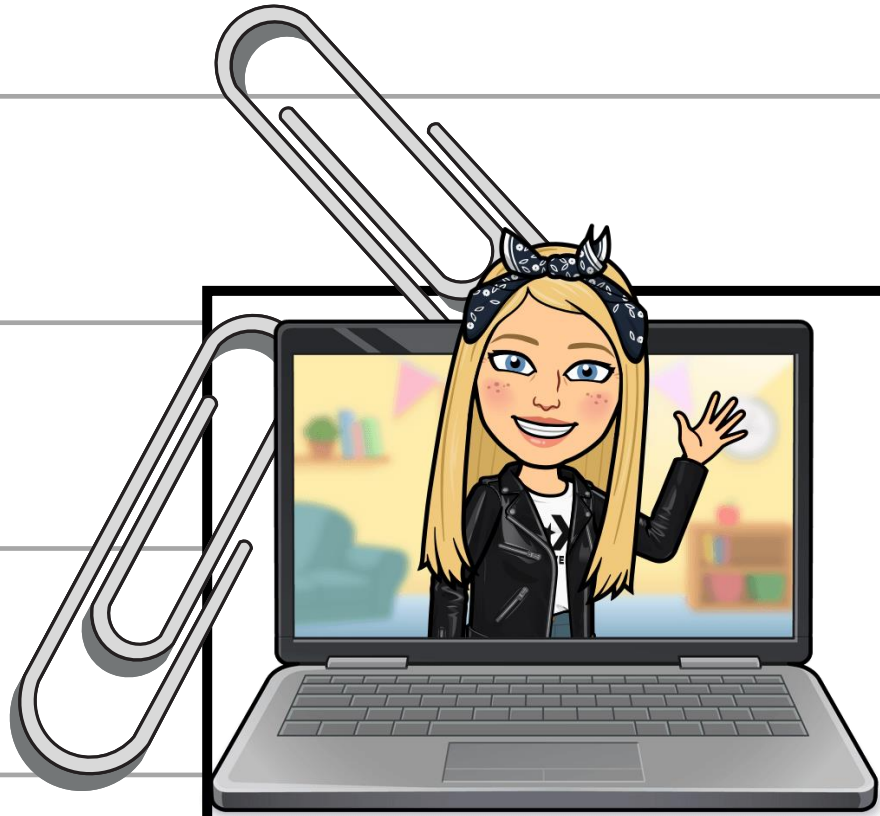

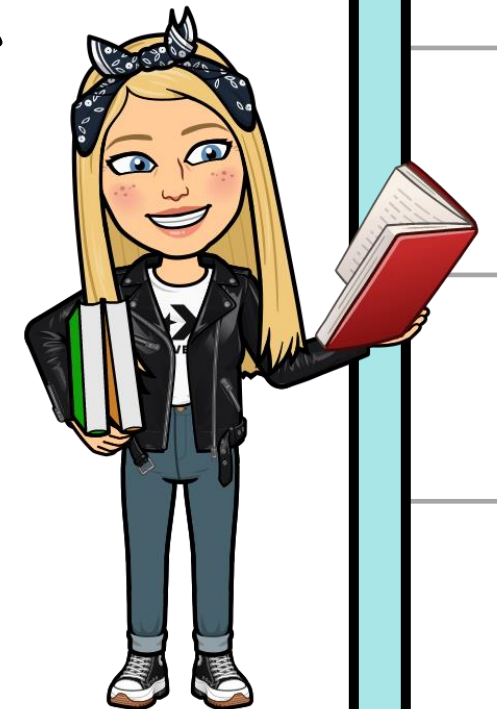

- Kindness: "Kindness is showing love and generosity to everyone. We should think of others and do our best for them. It's about being friendly, helpful and making others feel happy."



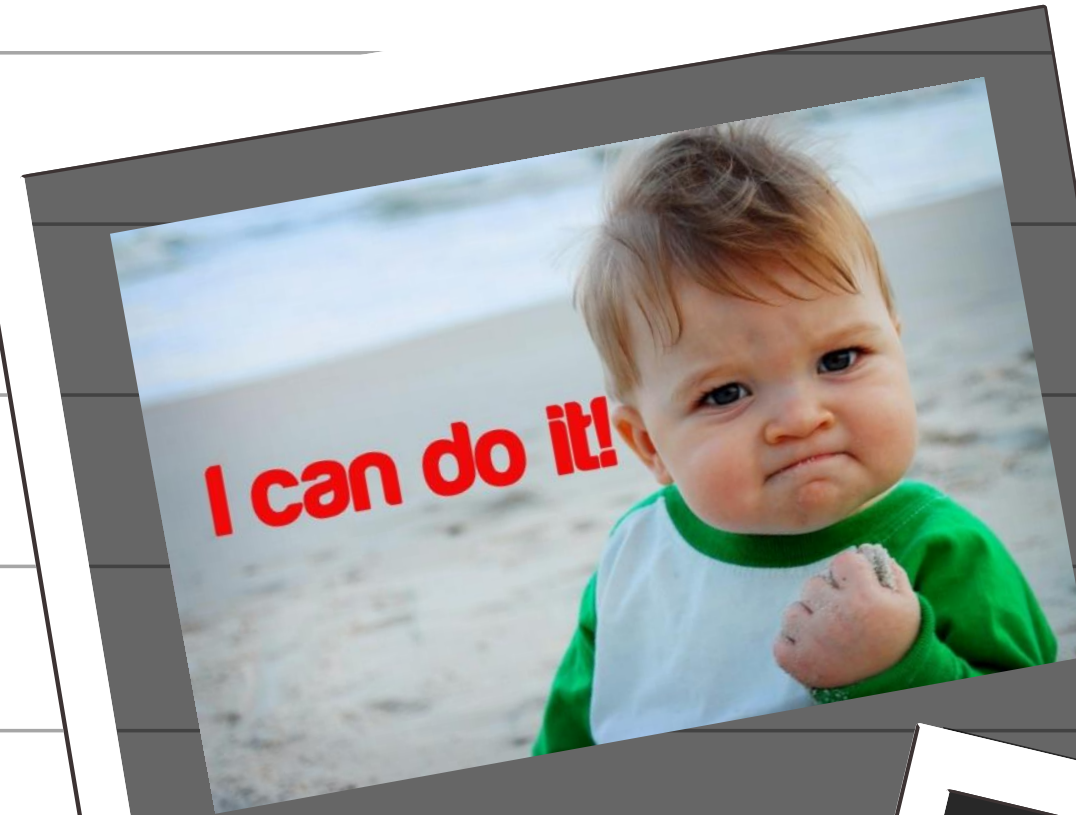
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Our Positive Relationships Charter

- I will be honest.



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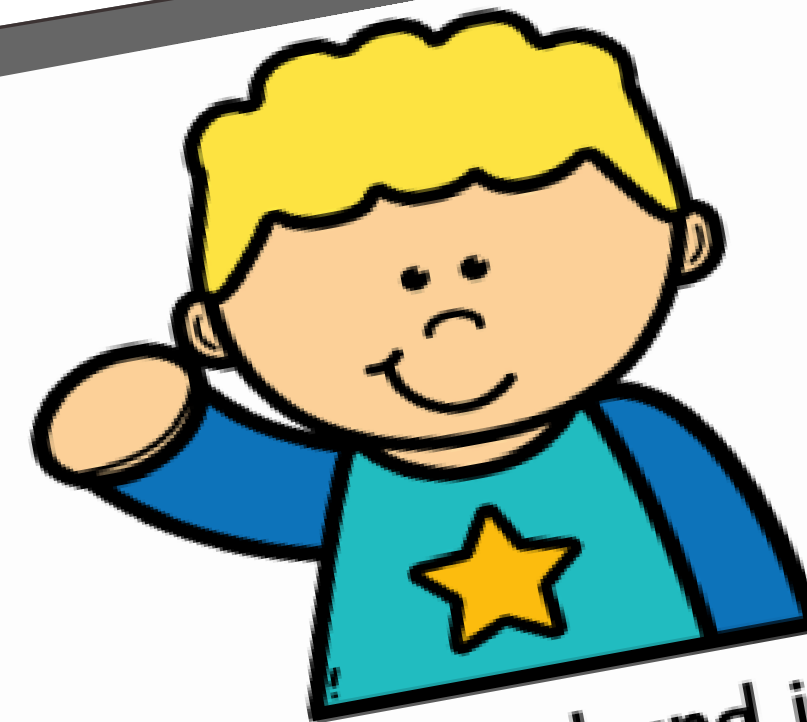
Our Class Charter

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Our Curriculum

Technology

The technologies curriculum area includes the study of digital literacy; computing science; technological developments in society and business; craft, design, engineering and graphics; food and textiles technology. We will utilize digital resources, such as Google Workspace for Education. We will explore creative digital skills through coding. We will learn to become responsible digital citizens and explore the important issues around online safety.

Health & Well-Being

We will explore how to support the emotional well-being of both ourselves and others. Alongside this, we will explore 'Food & Health' and 'Healthy Lifestyles', through topics such as substance misuse, healthy eating and hygiene. We will focus on our SHANARRI well-being indicators will help us to assess our progress in HWB.
