Maria Elena Henderson is a first-generation Salvadorian. Born in Los Angeles the oldest of three siblings, until age 13 she was led to believe she was born in San Salvador, El Salvador, as her parents wanted to foster pride in their native homeland. Maria loved the time she spent with her sister doing ceramics, embroidery, and crochet. At age 16, she was selected to perform with the first

"Young Americans" choir touring Europe noting "That was a wonderful wonderful time in my life." She grew up with the belief that in America, everyone has the opportunity to become the person they want to become with the help of God, family, friends, and a lot

of self initiative. Maria and her husband, Neil, are a blended family with 6 children, 3 boys and 3 girls, and 13 grandchildren.

Although she was diagnosed with Parkinson's in 2019, there were signs for 15 years before that including violent dreams and sleepwalking. She finally went to see a doctor after her daughters thought she was "walking funny". "My greatest challenges now are short term memory loss, midsection mobility, stress, sleep disorders, depression, loneliness, and the feeling of being smothered by society's dysfunction, and this Covid monster we are all dealing with."

"Since my diagnosis, I have been getting a lot of support from family, church, and the small groups I participate in, but last September I was introduced to the North County Parkinson's Support Group and the Oceanside chapter. After the first meeting my perspective has changed completely. What a true blessing this group has already been. The informational speakers are wonderful. The breakout groups are very supportive and I really enjoyed the small group lunch at Bobby's in October. It really changes everything when you realize you are not alone in this struggle."

In some of her darkest valleys, Maria has found that her faith is what sustains her particularly Proverbs 3. "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding." She is trying to do just that. "I am getting daily exercise, staying in touch with family and friends, getting out as much as possible, and praying for those who can't. Life is different now, but my life is blessed nonetheless. More than anything else we need to keep moving. Life is a gift."
