## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 210.600 PARAGRAPH A, OF ORDINANCE 234; CONCERNING CURFEW FOR PERSONS UNDER SEVENTEEN

Whereas, it is in the best interest of the Citizens of Ferrelview to maintain a healthy environment for children, therefore be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Ferrelview, Missouri as follows, to wit:

Section 1: Paragraph A of Section 210.600, Ordinance #210, is hereby repealed.

Section 2: The following shall be adopted as Paragraph A, Section 210.600 of Ordinance #210: "It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of seventeen (17) years to be in or upon any public place or way within the Village of Ferrelview between the hours of 11:00 P.M and 6:00 A.M. The provisions of this Section shall not apply to any such persons accompanied by a parent or guardian, to any such person upon an errand or other legitimate business directed by such person's parent or guardian, to any such person who is engaged in gainful, lawful employment during said time or in route to said employment, or to any such person who is attending or in route to or from any organized religious or school activity."

**Repealing conflicting ordinances:** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, shall be, and the same are hereby repealed; and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, as provided by law.
