① L LIFE



Preserve life above all else. People can't be replaced.

② E EXTENSION



Prevent the event or keep it from spreading. Minimize collateral damage.

③ C CONFINEMENT



Contain the emergency in as small an area as possible.

④ E EXTINGUISH



Bring the event to an end. Trace back to the source.

LECE HAPPENS SEQUENTIALLY AND RAPIDLY THROUGH ESTABLISHED TACTICS, TECHNIQUES, AND PROCEDURES.

THE THREE ESSENTIAL CAPABILITIES

Must be preserved in every emergency.



ACT

Do the job.



MOVE

Get resources where they're needed.



COMMUNICATE

Keep the flow of information.
