**ELEMENTARY ART HISTORY** ages 5-12

Learn about Art History from Ancient Egypt through Ancient Greece and Rome. Both 2 and 3 dimensional hands on art projects are done to reinforce the lesson. A variety of art media are used including drawing, papier maché, acrylic paint, and clay. Children learn about drawing profiles, Egyptian mummies and sarcophagus, Greek amphoras, the Parthenon, and mosaics. This is a fun way to learn about art history!

**MIXED MEDIA 3D ART** ages 12-16

This class uses a variety of art media to create beautiful pieces of three-dimensional artwork. Students learn about the principles of art including balance, proportion, emphasis, and movement. Projects include papier maché, wire art, a three-dimensional painting, a 'junque' art sculpture, and Oaxacan animals. This is a great class to boost one's creativity, work in the third dimension, and have fun in the process.

**DRAWING & PAINTING** ages 5-12

This is a wonderful class for beginner and young artists who want to improve their drawing and painting skills. Lessons include faces, shading, layout and design, landscape, and still life. In the drawing lessons, children work with a variety of art media including charcoal, pastels, oil pastels, pencils, and colored pencils. Both acrylics and watercolors are used in the painting lessons.

**DRAWING & PAINTING** ages 12-16

This class is designed for older students who have some drawing and painting experience. Lessons include still life, perspective, portraits, landscape, and animals. Design principles and artists are discussed when applicable. Art media in drawing include pencils, charcoal, and pastels. Both acrylic paints and watercolor are used in the painting lessons. Teens will enjoy the challenges in this art class.
