A Note from Fred:

Central Presbyterian Church is growing! Good things are happening. As we move towards the end of 2023 there are several things I want to highlight. First, on November 12, we received 28 pledges for close to \$150,000. That is a significant increase from last year. Thank you very much!

We have been making improvements on both our building and the grounds. We have a new parking lot; the front doors of the sanctuary are going to be refinished; and many improvements have been made inside. I am grateful to our Building and Grounds committee and their work to keep up with our facilities.

We will also make some additions to our Advent and Christmas celebrations. I will be giving a children's sermon each Sunday. This year we mailed 10,000 postcards inviting people to join us for the holiday season on Sundays and Christmas Eve. There will be a weekly prayer service in the chapel on Wednesdays at noon. Bethlehem Revisited takes place the first two weekends of December and we need docents to welcome guests to our sanctuary each evening. On December 21 we will have a Blue Christmas worship service at 6:00 pm. And on Christmas Eve we will have our regular 11:00 am service and we will also have two candlelight/communion services at 5:00 pm and 11:00 pm. I hope you will join us.

Finally, we have been involved in caring for our community. We collected 600 packages of lined paper for our school district and 600 cans of sweet potatoes for Waxahachie Care. Our congregation continues to support Presbyterian Children's Home And Services (PCHAS). Also, we are supporting Common Ground Ministries' Christmas With Dignity.

Donate new toys, unwrapped, at the church. We need your toys before December 8.

Good things are happening here at Central Presbyterian Church. To God be the glory.

Blue Christmas Service

What is a blue Christmas service?

A Blue Christmas service is a worship service that names and holds space for the sadness that accompanies the holidays. Heightened by the advertising of our consumerist culture, there is a definite Christmas ideal that includes neatly iced gingerbread houses, smiling children, and an excessive amount of neatly wrapped packages. These standards and the church's sometimes solitary focus on joy can make the holidays an isolating time for anyone who can't muster happiness or meet the criteria. A blue Christmas service is an invitation for anyone who wants to come and set their burden down, for a community to hold pain collectively.

This service is for a group of people who recognize that joy and sorrow intertwine, and those who love them.

The service falls on December 21—the shortest day of the year. This offers an opportunity the for community to reflect on darkness and light in a literal sense. When the darkness feels overwhelming, we can take comfort in knowing that God meets us here. And whether it is a seed in the soil, a baby in the womb, or Jesus in the tomb, we know that life comes out of the dark.

Central Presbyterian Church of Waxahachie is offering a Blue Christmas service this year on Thursday, December 21st at 6 p.m. in the Patrick Chapel. Please enter through the side door adjacent to the parking lot off Jackson Street by Bethlehem Revisited. We have a ramp and stairs. The chapel is just to the left of the stairway. This is a brief service of hope and light in the midst of the darkness. Please join us.



Toys are collected in various locations throughout Waxahachie and are then assembled and priced at 1/3 of the original value.

Christmas with Dignity is **December 10th** this year and will be held in the Undercroft at CPC. A decorated box is now in our sanctuary ready to

receive new, unwrapped toys. Currently there are only 3 toys in our box, which is usually full by the time the boxes are collected.
