What is a Church Elder Retreat?

Well first! It is January 22, 2023 Immediately following Worship!

Every Moderator of a Session has a different answer to this question. Here is mine:

We gather together for a fellowship meal after worship and then call the meeting to order to vote on an Omnibus motion which covers all the first-of-the-year business: to elect a Clerk of Session 2023 and a Treasurer 2023, when to hold Stated Session meetings, to approve Communion to be served on the first Sunday of every month and on holy days as designated on the Presbyterian Planning Calendar, to approve the budget for 2023, to call an Annual Meeting of the Congregation to review the 2022 Year End Report. Easy right!

After this, we make **Team Assignments** for our Administration Team (Finance/Personnel/Property), Communications Team, Worship and Music Team, Mission and Care Team, and Christian Education Team.

And then the fun stuff begins - Basic Elder Training Reminders!

Basically, we are reminded that Team Moderators call meetings and decisions are made via loving consensus. All planning decisions are made within the Team meetings and Motions (action items) are crafted in Team meetings, then sent to the Session, and then decisions are announced to the Congregation after approval from the Session. In my humble opinion, Stated Session Meetings should never last longer than an hour! The work of the church happens in Team meetings and the Session is serious about practicing permission-giving leadership.

Lastly, we Coordinate our Presbyterian Planning Calendars to include Team meeting times, bible studies, mission projects, special worship services, and fellowship meals. We literally get on the same page! Everything you ever wanted to know!
