If you have time and energy to spare help is needed preparing for the work day by packing up books, etc., and moving all to the top floor.





"Flowering of the Cross" is a church tradition practiced since ancient times to celebrate spring and the emerging new life in a very visual way. It is traditionally done on Easter Sunday morning. This year Central Presbyterian Church will again participate in this ancient practice.





Flowers may be placed on the cross during the sunrise service and throughout the day as people enter the church.

The "flowered cross" will then remain in front of the church through the following week which will offer, a unique visual reminder of Christ's resurrection and new life and new beginnings.

It is hoped that all will participate and even bring extra flowers for those who may not have any. The beautifully adorned cross will also offer a great backdrop for Easter pictures for families and individuals after the church service.
