A Note from Fred:

As we begin the month of September, I am reflecting on the various mission opportunities we will have close to our church home.

The first opportunity I want to mention is the Food Bags for Marvin Biomedical Academy (Elementary School). Waxahachie ISD is calling this program "Sacks of Snacks". As you may be aware, there are many children in our area who are food insecure. For some of these students their most nutritious and filling meals of the day come from their time at school. Sacks of Snacks provide students with food for the weekend that they can prepare for themselves.

This week, Priscilla Clore delivered 20 Sacks of Snacks to Marvin. We expect the number to rise to 30 Sacks of Snacks a week for our neighborhood Title I school. The total cost of each bag should be just under \$10.00. However, we need your help to fill 20-30 bags a week.

Here is the list of items for the food bags:

(no nuts or peanut butter)

2 shelf-stable white milk
1 shelf-stable chocolate milk
2 juice boxes
2 individual cereals
1 Package of chex mix or chips
Fruit roll ups
2 fruit cups
2 breakfast bars
Cheese crackers

The second mission we will highlight this month is the Presbyterian Children's Homes and Services (PCHAS). On Sunday, September 22, the Rev. Diane Pennington, a development officer with PCHAS, will be preaching; and Jamie Iglesias will be here to share her experience with PCHAS. We will have a reception immediately following the service to visit with Diane and Jamie about PCHAS ministries.

Protein: Beef jerky, tuna, etc.

On Sunday, September 29, we will Worship Outside the Walls (WOW). Instead of worshiping in our sanctuary, we will be working with some of our ministry partners. In the next few weeks, we will have more information about various mission opportunities in our community scheduled for that day.

One-By-One Ministries here in Waxahachie is looking for women volunteers to help expectant and new moms who may feel alone or unprepared to be a parent. One-By-One Ministry equips women from local congregations to serve as mentors and matches them with an expectant mom who is asking for help. Mentors offer support, friendship and love to the mom. Mentors also equip moms to be the best parent they can be, and finally, mentors assure moms of their value and worth, sharing the hope of Christ.

Mentors are **trained** to make visits with the mom using the **curriculum provided** by One-By-One. Moms are referred by pregnancy centers, health clinics, churches, schools and other community partners.

Mentors are expected to have at least one in-person meeting each month and on-going weekly contact by phone or text. Mentors meet with mom beginning prenatally and continuing until the child's first birthday. Mentors **do not** provide transportation, money or baby sitting.

One-By-One Ministries desires "to strengthen families, to reduce the incidence of child abuse and neglect through parent education, and improve the parenting skills of this generation to impact the next generation."




Women's Luncheon Saturday, September 14, Downstairs
