Team Captain Responsibilities

- Captains shall make sure that all forms and fees are collected and paid to club for member and league play on the League Form by the due date for Priority Registration.
- Captains shall relay important information from the board to their teammates. Board meeting minutes, calendar and other information are located on the Club website
- Captains should be responsible for the conduct of their team. Remember, proper sportsmanship and courtesy shall be given to everyone.
- Captains shall ensure that their wins and losses are properly recorded in the score book, located at the courts
- Matches can be rescheduled ONLY due to inclement weather (heat, cold, rain). A rescheduled match must occur within two (2) weeks of the originally scheduled match. The team unwilling or unable to reschedule a match will take a forfeit. If both teams opt not to reschedule, both games will be recorded as a "0" for each team. Before a proposed cancellation, communication must occur between the two captains no later than two (2) hours prior to the scheduled match.
- Captains should be checking on their team's status for the playoffs, especially during the second half of the season. If you know that your team cannot make the tournament, please contact, **Steve Choe**, EPBC Tournament Director as soon as possible at epbcsac@gmail.com
- Captains should be cognizant of all game rules. Any appeals to the board should come from the captain. Any rule clarification should be initiated by the captain. Game Rules are located on the club website

- Captains should be aware of the **start** and **end** of each league season and the date of playoff tournaments. This information is on the calendar on our club website.
- Captains should communicate any concerns to the board as soon as possible, or may attend a monthly board meeting if necessary. Board meetings are open to all EPBC Members and the public at large. Dates and times are on the calendar on our club website
