

St. Jerome's (Oconomowoc) 2nd Annual Volleyball Tournament

Divisions: 8th Grade Boys 9/14 6th Grade Girls 9/21 8th Grade Girls 9/28

Match times: Pool play begins at 4:30 PM. The 4 teams with the shortest drive time will play the first match of each pool. The next match starts as soon as the other ends.

Registration: please email stjeromelions.athletics@gmail.com or Ryan Lang via text/call @ 262-395-3855. Registrations will be accepted on a first-come, first serve basis. If payment and roster is not received by the deadline, the invite will pass to the next team. (Payment and roster will hold your spot. Please submit a copy of your league roster)

Admission: \$3 per person or \$10 per family. Food and Concessions will be available. No carry-ins. Grilled and freshly prepared food will be available in addition to traditional concessions items.

Tournament Format: 3 guaranteed matches with the potential of 5 matches.

Pool Play: Two Pools of 3 teams. Pool play consists of 2 sets to 21 (3rd to 15 if needed). One timeout allowed per match, per team. Teams will each be given 2 minutes of warm up. Pool winners and seeding will be determined by win percentage with point differential as tie breaker. Each pool winner receives a first round bye in bracket play.

Bracket Play: All teams will have two timeouts per match and a 2-minute warm-up prior to their first bracket match if desired. Matches consist of 2 sets to 21 (3rd to 15 if needed). 1st round: 2nd-Pool A vs 3rd-Pool B on Court 1 and 2nd-Pool B vs 3rd-Pool A on Court 2. 2nd round: the winner on court 1 plays 1st-Pool B and the winner on court 2 plays 1st-Pool A. The losing teams of the semi-finals play for 3rd on court 2. The championship game plays on court 1.

League team roster players only. No all-star or combined teams. Standard archdiocesan substitution rules.

One WIAA official per match.

The sitting team will provide two line-judges until the championship and third place matches. Parent volunteers or players for the associated team can line judge.

Team Trophy for champion and medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.
