Tringov's Musical Journey began in his hometown of **Kazanlak, Bulgaria**, where he was born on April 6, 1972. He started studying violin at age six and quickly revealed prodigious talent. At just **nine years old**, he won **a gold medal in 1981 at the Sixth National Music Festival in Stara Zagora**, becoming the contest's youngest laureate. This early success set the stage for rigorous musical training: in 1985, he entered **the Hristina Morfova School of Music**, and by 1988 he was admitted to **the prestigious National Music School "Lyubomir Pipkov" in Sofia**. Continuing his **professional training**, Tringov enrolled in the **National Music Academy "Prof. Pancho Vladigerov"** in Sofia after high school in 1991, studying with Professor **Elisaveta Kazakova**. His student years were distinguished by significant performance roles: **from 1991 to 1995 he served as first violinist of the New Symphony Orchestra**, one of Bulgaria's leading ensembles. He then toured across Europe from 1995 to 1999 as the **concertmaster (first violinist) of the "Teatro Lirico de Europe" Opera Orchestra**, gaining international experience performing in countries such as **Germany, France, Italy, Spain, and Sweden**. In 1996, Tringov earned his **Master of Music degree with honors**, solidifying his status as a highly trained classical musician. He also achieved notable competition successes, including a **Second Prize at the 1998 "Music and Earth" International Competition in Sofia** and a **Special Prize for virtuosity** (for his performance of **A. Bazzini's "La Ronde des Lutins"**), an honor given in memory of legendary violinist Vasko Abadjiev. These accolades, along with participating in the **1999 Paganini International Violin Competition in Genoa, Italy**, underscored Tringov's exceptional skill and promise. Expanding his horizons, Daniel M. Tringov moved to the **United States in 2002** to pursue advanced musical training and global experience. He earned a **full scholarship for violin performance at the University of Southern Mississippi**, where he won the **William T. Gower Concerto Award** and performed as a soloist in **Beethoven's Violin Concerto in D major** with the university symphony orchestra. Tringov then continued his studies at the **University of Southern California's Thornton School of Music** on a full merit scholarship, training under acclaimed violin pedagogue Professor **Alice Schoenfeld**. He completed a **Graduate Certificate in Violin Performance in 2006**, graduating with honors and receiving a **Certificate for Outstanding Academic Achievement** at USC. Born in Kazanlak, Bulgaria on April 6, 1972.

1981: First Musical Acclaim

Wins a *Golden Medal* at Bulgaria's National Music Festival at age 9, the youngest in his group.

1991–1999: Education & Early Career

Trains at prestigious Bulgarian music schools and serves as first violinist in leading orchestras like the New Symphony Orchestra (1991–1995) and Teatro Lirico de Europe Opera Orchestra (1995–1999).

1998: Competition Success

2019: Launch of Deutsche Classical

Founds **Deutsche Classical** in Munich – a boutique record label dedicated to high-fidelity classical music production and artist development.

2022: Multimedia Projects

Produces **Orpheus of Seuthopolis** (4K UHD art film) and oversees live-streamed concerts at the Rose Festival in Kazanlak, integrating classical music with modern media.

2024: Forbes "Men on Top" Recognition

Named among *Forbes Bulgaria's* "Men on Top" for 2024 – honored as a business leader who has merged artistic excellence with entrepreneurial success.

Media Production and Entrepreneurship: Alongside his performance career, Tringov has continually expanded into creative production and business leadership. In **2009**, he transitioned from performing full-time to focus on **composing, audio engineering, and producing** music at his own Global Art Entertainment studio in Connecticut (USA). For four years, he collaborated with other musicians – notably his wife, **Sifei Wen-Tringov**, a concert cellist – on recording projects, arrangements, and multimedia content. After spending several years in the United States, Tringov returned to Europe and led **Global Art Entertainment**, a production and artist management company, from a base in Sofia, Bulgaria. There he diversified his roles as a **photographer, creative director, and producer**, further blending visual media and design with music. Demonstrating his passion for collaborative innovation, in **2015** he co-founded the **String Art Quartet**, an ensemble of two violins and two cellos which he founded with Sifei Wen-Tringov. This project exemplifies Tringov's commitment to **exploring new chamber music formats** and bringing classical music to broader audiences through creative ensemble configurations. Founder & CEO of Deutsche Classical: In 2019, Daniel M. Tringov launched **Deutsche Classical**, a Bavarian boutique record label he leads as CEO. Headquartered in Munich, **Deutsche Classical** quickly gained a reputation for *innovating classical music production by fusing traditional artistry with cutting-edge technology*. Under Tringov's vision, the label employs advanced recording and mastering techniques – from high-end analog sound capture to digital enhancements and even **experimental uses of AI in composition and production** – all aimed at delivering the “finest sound” while preserving the authenticity of classical performances. He also emphasizes *cross-genre collaboration*, blending classical music with jazz, world, folk, and electronic elements to create fresh musical fusions and attract new audiences without sacrificing classical roots.
